
If I believe something that is different than what God has revealed in His word

- I am wrong? - Rom 3:4; Heb. 6:18

- The word of truth can be UNDERSTOOD - Eph 3:3-5
 - It CAN BE MISUNDERSTOOD 2 Pet 3:16-18; Eph 5:17; Gal
 1:6-9; 2 Thes 2:10-12
- The word of truth must be "handled correctly" 2 Tim
 2:15; Heb 5:12-14
 - It Can be Mishandled 2 Tim 2:16-18; Gal. 1:6-9; 2 Pet 3:16




SOME THINGS THAT HINDER

- Pride a lack of respect for God & His word - Isa. 66:2; Prov. 1:7; James 4:6-10


SOME THINGS THAT HINDER

"THE WORD OF TRUTH" SOME THINGS THAT HINDER



- Thinking that we can't (For clergy only; mysticism; have to have direct Holy Spirit help) Eph. 3:3-5; 5:17
- Preconceived ideas (To hold to & defend what we already believe) - Mat 15:7-9; Rom 10:1-3; Prov. 14:12

NEED FOR DILIGENCE

- Diligently seeking God Heb 11:6; Prov. 8:17
- Commanded to diligently keep
 God's precepts Psalm 119:4
- Giving ALL DILIGENCE to grow & make our calling & election sure - 2 Pet 1:3-10; Heb 6:11; Phili 2:12; 2 Pet 3:14

AIMING FOR GOD'S APPROVAL

- Knowledge of God's words essential - Psalm 25:1-5; Col. 1:9,10; Rom 12:2; 2 Pet 3:18
- Believing God's words essential Heb. 11:6 ...; Rom. 4:17-24;
 10:13-17; Eph. 2:8,9; etc.
- Doing God's will essential Jam.
 1:21-25; 2:14-26; Luke 6:46; Mat
 7:21-23; Heb. 5:8,9; etc.

BEING A WORKER FOR GOD

- We know we are NOT justified by the works of the Law of Moses! Our work for God IN NO WAY merits salvation - Rom. 3:21.27; 4:1-6; 11:6; Gal. 3:10; Eph. 2:8,9
- But we MUST work or our FAITH will NOT save us James 2:14-26
- MUST work out our own salvation w/ fear Phili 2:12; Tit 2:14

WE CAN KNOW OUR WORK IS ACCEPTED

- We KNOW we are pleasing to God when we, by faith, do what He says!
 Gen. 6; 12; 17; 22; Rom. 4:19-22; Heb. 11; 2 Tim. 3:17; etc.
- We KNOW God is displeased when we do NOT do what He says Gen. 4; 19; Lev. 10:1-4; 1 Sam. 13; 15; Jere. 6:16-23; Mat. 7:23
- God has told us what He wants 2 Tim. 3:16,17; 2 Pet. 1:3

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Right attitude Respect / Humility (Isa. 66:2; Prov. 1:7)
- Love for truth (2 Thes2:10-12; Psalm 119:97-104)
- Honesty (Luke 8:15; Acts 17:11,12)
- Wisdom (Eph 5:17)

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Trust (2 Tim. 3:16,17; John 17:17; Rom 10:17)
- Hunger (Mat 5:6; 1 Pet 2:2;Ps 119:97-104; Prov 2:1-7)
- Expectation (Eph 3:3-5)
- A desire to obey it (Jn 3:21;7:17; 8:31,32; Jam 1:21)

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Examine context (Psalm 119:160;
 Prov. 30:5; 2 Tim. 3:16; John 3:16;
 6:44,45; 1 Cor. 1:17; Rom. 9)
 - Recognizing the type of language used - (Literal / figurative? Apocalyptic?) - Gen. 1,2; Rev 1:1
 - Recognizing the different ways terms are used - (spirit; soul; one; baptism) - Gen. 1:20,30; Num. 31:28; 1 Cor. 12:13; Rom. 8:16

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Examine context (Psalm 119:160;
 Prov. 30:5; 2 Tim. 3:16; John 3:16;
 6:44,45; 1 Cor. 1:17; Rom. 9)
 - Who is speaking? Gen 3:4,5
 - Who is being spoken to? Jn 14-16
 - What is the main point? Rom. 4,9
 - Understanding terms? Ep 2:8,9
 - How terms are used in a particular passage? Mat 3:11 / Acts 2:38

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Knowledge of historical circumstances and customs - (John 13:14; 1 Thes 5:26)
- Recognizing that the Bible doesn't deal with everything specifically -
- However, the scriptures provide the principles where every important question can be answered - (1 Tim. 3:16,17; Heb. 5:12-14; 2 Pet 3:16)

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- Truth harmonizes with truth.
- Each & every statement in scripture is true, but is not the whole truth.
- Must consider everything that the scripture says about a subject.
- When teaching what the Bible teaches, it is not "just a matter of opinion or interpretation." It is the TRUTH - (1 Pt 4:11; Mat 22:31,32).

MUST HANDLE GOD'S WORD CORRECTLY

- What must I do to be saved?
- What things are sinful?
- ▶ How do I worship God?
- How should the church be organized?
- What kind of things should a church be engaged in?
