Matthew 5:13-16 (NKJV)

13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

- We live in a WICKED & DARK world - (Gen 6:5; 2 Tim 3:1-5)
- The PEOPLE of GOD are to be a positive INFLUENCE & guiding EXAMPLE — (John 17:15-18; Rom. 2:17-24; Phili. 2:15,16)
- In order to be EFFECTIVE, we MUST be genuinely HOLY in character, word, & deeds. (5:3-12; Jn 17:15-18; 2 Cor. 6:14-7:1; 1 Pet 1:13-17; 2:11,12)

SALT & LIGHT

We can be a positive influence in this world ONLY if we are very different from the world!

YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Mark 9:49-50 (NKJV)


49 "For everyone will be seasoned with fire, and every sacrifice will be seasoned with salt. 50 Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another."



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Luke 14:34-35 (NKJV)

34 "Salt is good; but if the salt has lost its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? 35 It is neither fit for the land nor for the dunghill, but men throw it out. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

- Flavoring foods
- Preserving fish
- Drain blood from meats
- Infants rubbed with salt -
- Treatment for tooth decay and tooth aches
- Ingredient in the sacred anointing oil
- Sacrifices (Num. 18:19)
- Necessary for life



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Seasons

- Job said, "Can flavorless food be eaten without salt? Or is there any taste in the white of an egg?" (Job 6:6)
- Our words should be with salt, i.e. wholesome and palatable – (Col. 4:6)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Preserves


- There were not enough salty saints to save the antediluvian world – (Gen. 6:7-13)
- Abraham pleading with the Lord regarding Sodom - (Gen 18:20-32)
- Jerusalem "If you can find a man . . . I will pardon her" (Jer. 5:1)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Heals

- Salt has antiseptic and healing properties.
- In Bible times when babies were born, babies were given a saline bath to hold down infection – (Ezekiel 16:4)
- We live in a sick world infected by sin – are we salty enough to help it?



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Irritates

- Salt burns in a wound!
- The truth of God's Word, when rubbed into this diseased world, will sting (Mat. 5:10-12; Luke 6:22; John 15:20; 2 Tim 3:12)
- Many prefer a nonirritating brand of the Gospel – (2 Tim. 4:3.4)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Penetrates

- In order for salt to season, preserve, heal or irritate – it must come into contact with that which it is intended to affect.
- We must get the salt to the source, where it can penetrate, activate, and change society – (John 17:13-18; 1 Thes 1:8)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Salt Causes Thirst

- You can lead a horse to water but you can't make it drink - - - but you can give it salt.
- Consistent godly influence is very powerful (1 Pet. 3:1; 1 Cor. 9:19-22)
- The sermon you preach is not nearly as effective as the sermon you live!



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Polluted Salt Is Useless

- "Salt seasons and preserves beef, NOT because it is like beef, but because it is very much unlike it." - Chesterton
- Our positive influence is ONLY found in our holy distinctiveness – (Luke 14:34; 2 Cor. 6:14-7:1; James 4:4)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Polluted Salt Is harmful

- Brings dishonor and and a reproach upon God and His people - (Rom 2:24; 1 Tim 5:14; 6:1)
- Inconsistency in the lives of those who profess to be followers of Christ has indeed caused many to be offended! - (Mat. 18:7; Titus 2:1-8)



YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Polluted Salt Is Thrown Out

- It is to be discarded trampled under the feet of men – (Luke 14:35; Mat 7:23; 25:41)
- The REAL possibility of one losing their salvation & being lost - (John 15:1-10; Rom. 11:17-22; Heb. 10:24-39)



YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

A City On A Hill

- Those with the character of Christ and follow Him will radiate His light – (John 8:12; Prov 4:18; Eph 5:8-10)
- Our Christianity should be evident. Jesus expects His followers to be seen by the world (e.g., Jn 13:35; 17:21; 1 Peter 3:15)



Matthew 5:14 (NKJV)
14 "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Don't Hide Your Light

- Collectively we need to be busy preaching and teaching the gospel – (pulpit - radio – internet – supporting preachers around the world) — (Mat. 28:19,20; Mk. 16:15,16; Acts 8:4; 1 The 1:8)
- The greatest impact will be accomplished on the individual level!

Matthew 5:15 (NKJV)

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Don't Hide Your Light

- Must be actively walking in the light (1 John 1:5,6)
- You were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord.
 Walk as children of light – (Eph 5:8-19; 1 Pet 2:9)
- Our light is to be seen by men in the world – (Phili 2:15, 16)
- Not the same as those Jesus condemned – (Mat 6:2, 16-18)

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Morality That Glorifies God

- We are to be morally pure (Eph 5:3; 1 Cor 6:9-11; Gal 5:19-21)
- We cannot be a positive influence in a morally depraved society while engaging in, approving of, or compromising with worldliness (Fornication, Homosexuality, MDR, Abortion, Drunkenness, Injustice, ...)

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV)

16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Morality That Glorifies God

EPHESIANS 5:3-7 (NKJV)

But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; 4 neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. 5 For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. 6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. 7 Therefore do not be partakers with them.

Morality That Glorifies God

EPHESIANS 5:8-13 (NKJV)

⁸ For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), ¹⁰ finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. ¹¹ And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose *them*. ¹² For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. ¹³ But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light.

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Morality That Glorifies God

1 PETER 4:1-4 (NKJV)

Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, ² that he no longer should live the rest of *his* time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. ³ For we *have spent* enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles—when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. ⁴ In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of *you*.

Speech That Glorifies God

- Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, . . . – (Eph 5:4)
- Sound speech that cannot be condemned, . . . (Titus 2:8)
- "But, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head— Christ." -(Eph 4:15)

Pure – Truthful
Loving – Helpful Instructive - Uplifting

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV)

Dress That Glorifies God

- Modest clothing Professing godliness – (1 Tim 2:9,10)
 - Not revealing -
 - Not extravagant -
 - Not caught up in worldly fashions —
 - Not false humility -

Self-Control Glorifying God

- There should be no fleshly appetite over which our spiritual mind does not rule – (1 Cor. 6:12; 1 Cor 9:27)
 - Moderation in all things allowed -(Rom. 14:15-23; 1 Cor. 10:23)
 - Abstinence from all things forbidden - (1 Cor. 6:19; Col. 3:5)

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV)

God Honoring Attitude

- The Beatitudes, [humility, hate sin, meekness, hunger for God, merciful, pure, peacemakers, faithful] (Mat 5:3-12)
- A supreme Love for God and a sincere love for our fellowman (Mark 12:29-31; 1 Cor. 13:3-8)
- Optimistic (Phili 4:8,12,13)

- Attendance / reverence— (Heb 10:25; 12:28)

16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.







PHILIPPIANS 2:12-18 (NKJV)

12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; 13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. 14 Do all things without complaining and disputing, 15 that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
