


To Define "FORMALISM"





- 1 *mass noun* Excessive adherence to prescribed forms.
 - 1.1 The use of forms of worship without regard to inner significance.
 - 1.2 The basing of ethics on the form of the moral law without regard to intention or consequences.
 - 1.3 Concern or excessive concern with form and technique rather than content in artistic creation.
 - 1.4 (in the theatre) a symbolic and stylized manner of production.
 - 1.5 The treatment of mathematics as a manipulation of meaningless symbols.


To Define "FORMALISM"



1: the practice or the doctrine of strict adherence to prescribed or external forms (as in religion or art); also: an instance of this

2: marked attention to arrangement, style, or artistic means (as in art or literature) usually with corresponding deemphasis of content

To Define "FORMALISM"




PLEASE DO NOT MISUNDERSTAND!

Beware of extremes. The misuse of a thing is no argument against the right use of it.


We MUST Follow NT PATTERN / FORM

¹³ Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.


We MUST Follow NT PATTERN / FORM

² Now I praise you, brethren, that you remember me in all things and keep the traditions just as I delivered *them* to you.


We MUST Follow NT PATTERN / FORM


On One Hand





swallow a camel!



²⁷ "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead *men's* bones and all uncleanness. ²⁸ Even so you also outwardly appear righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.



Worship & service MUST be in **BOTH**Spirit & Truth — John 4:24; Rom 12:1-2

Why IS FORMALISM Such A Threat?



It appeals to the carnal mind (self centered, arrogant, materialistic, unregenerate) — 1 Cor. 3:1-3; James 3:14-4:6

It appeals to the self-righteous (religious but proud, self-sufficient) — Luke 18:9-14, 18-23

It appeals to the hypocrite — (they love the praises of men) — Mt. 6:1-18; 23

HEED The Warning / Take Necessary ACTION

Revelation 2:5 (NKIV)

from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place--unless you repent.

- Remember Virtue of Recall Luke 15:17-21; Eph 1:3-14
- Honesty self investigation 2 Cor. 13:5; Heb 12:15
- Repent & Return Change of mind, heart / put the Lord first / His will / His work / His purposes FOR HIM!
- Only ONE thing put them in danger / only one thing could restore them Mat 6:19-33
