Mat 28:16-20

Mat 28:16 - disciple Strongs: G3101

μαθητής mathetes math-ay-tes'

From G3129; a *learner*, that is, *pupil:* - disciple.

Mat 28:19 - make disciples

Strongs: G3100

μαθητεύω mathēteuō math-ayt-yoo'-o

From G3101; intransitively to become a pupil; transitively to disciple, that is, enrol as

scholar: - be disciple, instruct, teach.

Original Language Word Meanings

Act 11:25-26

Act 11:26- disciple

Strongs: G3100

μαθητεύω matheteuo math-ayt-yoo'-o

From G3101; intransitively to become a pupil; transitively to disciple, that is, enroll as scholar: -

be disciple, instruct, teach.

Act_11:26- Christian

Strongs: G5546

Χριστιανός Christianos khris-tee-an-os'

From G5547; a Christian, that is, follower of Christ: - Christian.

Summarizing

- A disciple is a learner, a pupil
- A Christian is a follower of Christ
- A Christian is a disciple of Christ, that is a learner and follower of Christ

True vs False Discipleship?

Joh 8:31

Joh 8:31 – believed Strongs: G4100

πιστεύω pisteuō pist-yoo'-o

From G4102; to *have faith* (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), that is, *credit*; by implication to *entrust* (especially one's spiritual well being to Christ): - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

<u>Joh 8:31</u> – **abide Strongs: G3306** μένω menō *men'-o*

A primary verb; to *stay* (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy): - abide, continue, dwell, endure, be present, remain, stand, tarry (for), X thine own.

Therefore to "truly" be a Christian, or Christ's disciple have to abide in His Word.

A Disciple to Other than Christ?

1Co 1:10-13; 2Pe 2:1-3

Christian's Goals

- Be like Jesus <u>Luk_6:40</u>
- Be conformed to His image Rom 8:29; 2Co 3:18

What are marks of a Christian?

- Abides in Jesus' words Joh 8:31; Mat 7:21-27
- Loves the brethren <u>Joh 13:34-35</u>; <u>Joh 15:12</u>
- Bears much fruit Joh 15:8; Mat 5:16

Cost Of Discipleship

- Jesus must come first <u>Luk 14:26</u>; <u>Mat 10:34-36</u>
- Must forsake all to follow Jesus <u>Luk 14:33</u>
- Must be willing to suffer for Jesus <u>Luk 14:27</u>

- Rest for our souls Mat 11:28-30
- Freedom from sin 1 In 1:9; Eph 1:7
- The gift of the Spirit Gal 5:22-23
- Peace beyond understanding Rom 5:1; Php 4:6-7
- Joy beyond words Joh 15:11; Php 4:4
- Love beyond knowledge Eph 3:17-19; 1 n 3:16
- Fellowship in God's family Mar 10:28-30
- Comfort, hope for the future <u>2Co 1:3-5</u>; <u>1Th 4:13-18</u>

Rewards Of Discipleship

- Present blessings.
 - o Peace, joy, love <u>Joh 14:27</u>; <u>Joh 15:9-11</u>
 - o Fellowship in the family of God Mar_10:28-30

- Confess Rom 10:9-10
- Be baptized Act 22:16; Mar 16:16
