




MUCH CONFUSION







- NO place for more divine instruction!
- We NEED TO BE satisfied with what the Spirit has said about himself, & other things!

The WORD "SPIRIT" USED DIFFERENTLY

SPIRIT

pneuma (πνεῦμα, 4151) primarily denotes "the wind" (akin to pneo, "to breathe, blow"); also "breath"; then, especially "the spirit," which, like the wind, is invisible, immaterial and powerful. The NT uses of the word may be analyzed approximately as follows:


"(a) the wind, John 3:8 (where marg. is, perhaps, to be preferred); Heb. 1:7; cf. Amos 4:13, Sept.; (b) the breath, 2 Thess. 2:8; Rev. 11:11; 13:15; cf. Job 12:10, Sept.; (c) the immaterial, invisible part of man, Luke 8:55; Acts 7:59; 1 Cor. 5:5; Jas. 2:26; cf. Eccl. 12:7, Sept.; (d) the disembodied (or 'unclothed,' or 'naked,' 2 Cor. 5:3, 4) man, Luke 24:37, 39; Heb. 12:23; 1 Pet. 4:6; (e) the resurrection body, 1 Cor. 15:45; 1 Tim. 3:16; 1 Pet. 3:18; (f) the sentient element in man, that by which he perceives, reflects, feels, desires, Matt. 5:3; 26:41; Mark 2:8; Luke 1:47, 80; Acts 17:16; 20:22; 1 Cor. 2:11; 5:3, 4; 14:4, 15; 2 Cor. 7:1; cf. Gen. 26:35; Isa. 26:9; Ezek.



- An ATTITUDE
 - Bondage/Adoption (Rom. 8:15)
 - Stupor (Rom 11:8)
 - Antichrist —(1Jn 4:3)
 - Truth —(1 John 4:6)
 - Meekness —(Gal 6:1)


The WORD "SPIRIT" USED DIFFERENTLY



THE HOLY SPIRIT -

- Promised to the apostles by Jesus— (John 14:26; 15:26; 16:13; etc.)
- Empowered the apostles & teachers (Acts 2:1-4,17,33; 8:5-16)
- Revealed (1 Peter 1:21; Eph. 3:3-5; 2 Tim. 3:16,17)
- Confirmed the apostles & prophets as God's spokesmen - (Heb. 2:4)

The Prominence of the Holy Spirit




In The O.T. -

- Mentioned 88 times
- Referred to in 23 books out of 39
- Often by "Spirit of God"

In The N.T. -

- Mentioned 264 times
- Referred to in 24 books out of 27
- > 57 references in the book of Acts


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the life of Christ

- His involvement in the birth of Jesus Jesus was conceived of the Holy Spirit in the womb of Mary Mt 1:20; Lk 1:30-35
- Various individuals were filled with the Spirit to make pronouncements about His birth - Elizabeth & Zacharias, mother & father of John the Baptist - Lk 1:41-42, 67-79 / Simeon, who saw the infant Jesus presented in the Temple - Lk 2:25-35


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the life of Christ

- His presence at the baptism by John Descended in bodily form like a dove Lk 3:21-22 Even "alighting upon Him" Mt 3:16
- His presence during the temptations of Jesus - was "filled with the Holy Spirit" - Lk 4:1
- Jesus was "led by the Spirit" into the wilderness Lk 4:1; Mt 4:1


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the life of Christ

- His power during ministry "in the power of the Spirit" to teach in the synagogues Lk 4:14-15
- He applied Isaiah's prophecy to Himself, "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me..."- Lk 4:16-21
- Jesus claimed to cast out demons by the power of the Holy Spirit - Mt 12:28


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the Christian's life

- His involvement in our becoming Christians:
 - We are convicted of sin by the Holy Spirit - Jn 16:7-8
 - We are "born again" of the Spirit - Jn 3:5-8
 - We are "renewed" of the Holy Spirit - Ti 3:4-6


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the Christian's life

- His presence in our lives as Christians
 - We "live in the Spirit" Ga5:25a
 - We are to "walk in the Spirit", producing the "fruit of the Spirit" Ga 5:25b,16-18,22-23
 - We must set our minds on "the things of the Spirit" - Ro 8:5-6


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



In the Christian's life

- His presence in our lives as Christians
 - It is "by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body" as we are "led by the Spirit" - Ro 8:12-14
 - The Holy Spirit "makes intercession for us" in our prayers Ro 8:26-27
 - God strengthens us "with might through His Spirit" in the inner man
 - Ep 3:16


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



He is the source of truth

- The O.T. scriptures given by the Holy Spirit 2 Pe 1:20-21; 1 Pe 1:10-11
- ▶ Jesus told His apostles that the Holy Spirit would teach them "all things", and guide them "into all truth" - Jn 14:25-26; 16:12-13


The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



He is the source of truth

- The Holy Spirit HAS revealed ALL truth of God that we can know (Dt 29:29; Jn 16:13)
- There is no other way to know the truth of God's Will except by what the Holy Spirit revealed to the apostles (1 Co 2:10-13)

The Prominence of the Holy Spirit



He is the source of truth


1 Corinthians 2:10–13 (NKJV)

¹⁰ But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. ¹¹ For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. ¹³ These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.



Source Of Valid, Objective, Information!

- WE MUST EXAMINE WHAT THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS SAID ABOUT HIMSELF
 - Much error is taught about the nature of the Holy Spirit - (Arianism / Modalism / etc.)
 - Is the Holy Spirit an impersonal force? / just a manifestation of the Father? / A person of the Godhead?



Source Of Valid, Objective, Information!

- WE MUST EXAMINE WHAT THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS SAID ABOUT HIMSELF
- Many Misunderstand the working of the Holy Spirit
 - Holy Spirit baptism?
 - Gift of the Holy Spirit?
 - Miraculous gifts?
 - Indwelling?
 - How He leads us?



Most misunderstanding is not so much "what the Holy Spirit does" but "HOW" He does it!
