


Luke 9:23-26 (NKJV)




- Ananias, with Sapphira his wife Acts 5:1-11

- Demetrius, idolaters in Ephesus Acts 19:24-34








Acts 26:27-29 (NKJV)




- MANY were not willing to change their religion! —

- MANY were not willing to give up their sin —




- The jailor in PHILIPPI

 - ▶ 2 Thes. 1:6-12




- A few in **ATHENS**(even though they were steeped in idolatry and human philosophy)

 - ▶ 1 Thes 1:9,10




- Many in CORINTH (even in the midst of immorality)
 - Acts 18:8-11
 - ▶ 1 Cor. 6:9-11
 - ≥ 2 Cor. 6:14-7:1
 - ▶ Rom. 6:1-23
 - ▶ Eph. 4:17-5:21
 - ▶ 1 Pet. 1:13-21; 4:1-6



- Many in EPHESUS believed, fearing the Lord, confessed their deeds & repented (even at great financial cost)
 - Acts 19:18-20
 - Luke 18:18-27
 - ▶ 1 Tim. 6:5-11,19
 - ▶ Heb 13:5
 - Mat. 16:26




- The EXAMPLE of the apostle **PAUL** ...
 - Risked his life —
 (preaching the gospel was dangerous) —
 - Damascus, Ac. 9:22-25; 1 Cor. 11:32,33;
 - Jerusalem, Acts 9:29;
 - lconium, Acts 14:5,6,
 - Lystra, Acts 14:19; etc.



- The EXAMPLE of the apostle PAUL ...
 - Imprisoned several times:
 - Philippi Acts 16:16-25;
 - Arrested in Jerusalem Acts 21:26-36;
 - In Caesarea Acts 23:23-26:32;
 - ▶ Rome Acts 28:14-31; etc.




The EXAMPLE of the apostle PAUL ...






MANY ARE NOT WILLING TO PAY THE PRICE
