

The Use of Biblical Metaphors



WARNING: MUST NOT force every detail of a metaphor to have an important meaning or application.

INSTRUCTION: SEEK for the main lesson and intended application of the metaphor.

APPLICATION: PRINCIPLES applied from the metaphor are to be applied in harmony with other Biblical teaching.

- Christ's physical body (John 19:38-42; 20:12; 1 Cor. 10:16; Heb 10:5,10)
 - The church of Christ (Eph. 1:22, 23; 4:4; 5:23, 30; Col. 1:18, 24; 2:19; 3:15)

Individual members of Christ's universal body are to be a part of, serve in & help nourish the local church (1 Cor. 12:12-30; Rom. 12:3-21; Eph. 4:11-16)

The Body of CHRIST

- Emphasizes our obligation to God and relation to Him through Christ (Eph. 2:16; Rom. 12:1-8)
- Emphasizes our obligation and relation to every other believer in the world (Rom. 12:9-13; 1 Cor. 10:17; Eph. 3:6)

Emphasizes our obligation and relation to every other member of the local body of believers of which we are a part (Eph. 4:11-16; Rom. 12:4-17; 1 Cor. 12:12-27)

¹ I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, ³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

- Demands diligent pursuit of attitudes promoting unity (1-3)
- Demands we stand united upon truth (4-6,15)
- Demands we grow In truth by the Lord's provisions (7-15)
- Demands we use our God given abilities that the body grow (7-16)

The Body of Christ United

Ephesians 4:1-16

- A local "body of Christ" should be "fitly framed and knit together through that which every member supplies."
- Success & growth requires the cooperative efforts of individual Christians "according to the working in due measure of each several part" for the increase of the body "unto the building up of itself in love" (Eph. 4:16-17).

Romans 12:3-16

Romans 12:3–5 (NKJV) ³ For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of *himself* more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. ⁴ For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, ⁵ so we, *being* many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

I Corinthians 12:12-27

1 Corinthians 12:12–14 (NKJV) ¹² For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. ¹³ For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body-whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. ¹⁴ For in fact the body is not one member but many.

The Body of Christ United

I Corinthians 12:12-27

- Emphasizes unity NOT division (12,13,18,20)
- Emphasizes being a participant – NOT a spectator (14-20)
- Emphasizes equality NOT superiority (15-17, 21-24)
- Emphasizes dependence NOT independence (14,17,21-27)

I Corinthians 12:12-27

1 Corinthians 1:10 (NKJV) ¹⁰ Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you, but *that* you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
