


John 8:42-47 (NKJV)


WE WILL NOT LIVE IN SIN


WE WILL HEAR JESUS'S APOSTLES



WE WILL OBEY GOD


When we obey God's commands, we demonstrate our love for him (1 John 5:3; John 14:23,24)


IF WE ARE "OF GOD" ...


