
## Hebrews 3:12–19 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; 13 but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. 14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, 15 while it is said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion." 16 For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? 17 Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? 19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

#### OT SAINTS WHO REBELLED COULD NOT ENTER PSALM 95:6-11


NT SAINTS WHO REBEL WILL NOT ENTER HEBREWS 3:12-19


### WHY WE MUST HEAR JESUS (HEBREWS 3:1-6)



- Christ is apostle & High Priest 3:1
  - Written to Christians "holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling ... of our confession" - 3:1; 1 Pet 2:9; 2 Thes 2:14; Col 1:12
  - Apostle: "one sent" by the Father to declare His will (Heb. 1:2,3; John 17:18,19; 20:21; Mat. 17:5; 28:18-20)
  - High Priest: Mediator, Advocate; offered Himself for us (2:17; 4:14,15; 5:1-10; 7:27; 9:12)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

### WHY WE MUST HEAR JESUS (HEBREWS 3:1-6)



- Moses was God's servant, Jesus is God's Son - 3:2-6
  - Christ superior to Moses as builder of His own house (3:2-4; 1:3; Col 1:1-18; Mt 16:18; Ep. 2:21, 22; 1 Ti. 3:15)
  - "Son over God's house" (3:6; Mt 17:5)
  - "Whose house we [believers] are "IF" [conditioned on] we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end. (3:6; 4:11; 6:11; 10:23, 35, 38, 39).

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

## BEWARE BRETHREN (HEBREWS 3:7-15)



- A warning from the Israelites in the Old Testament (3:7-19)
  - The writer quotes Ps 95:7-11
    - "Today, if you will hear His voice"
      (Those to whom the Psalmist wrote)
    - "Do not harden your hearts" (They refused to allow God to lead them)
    - "They tempted Me, proved Me"
    - "They do always err in their heart"
    - "They do not know My ways."
    - "They shall not enter My rest."

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

### BEWARE BRETHREN (HEBREWS 3:7-15)



- A warning from the Israelites in the Old Testament (3:7-19)
  - The Hebrew writer applies Ps 95:7-11 as a warning to Christians (3:6-11; cf. 1 Cor. 10:1-13)
  - "Today, if you will hear His voice"(3:8; Jam 1:22; 4:13-15; 2 Cor. 6:2)
  - "Do not harden your hearts" (Ex. 8:15; 1 Sa. 6:6; 2 Ki. 17:14; Mat. 13:15. Ac. 19:9. Ro. 2:5, 6)

Do Not Harden **Your Heart** PHARAOH - Ex. 8:15 JEWS - 1 Sa. 6:6

### WE CAN BE LIKE THEM

"In the day of trial in the wilderness"

"test God, Try God,"

"go astray in OUR heart"

"not knowing God's ways"

"shall not enter God's rest."

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

### BEWARE BRETHREN (HEBREWS 3:7-15)



Do Not Harden Your Heart PHARAOH - Ex. 8:15 JEWS - 1 Sa. 6:6

#### How A Heart Can Become "HARD"

- Fail to acknowledge Jesus as LORD (Ex 5:2; Mat. 7:21-23; Luke 6:46)
- Embrace counterfeits (Exodus 7:10-12; Galatians 1:6-7; 2 Tim 4:3,4)
  - Not willing to pay the price of obedience (Exodus 5:4; 10:7; Luke 9:23-26; Philippians 3:7)
  - Develop a Habit of Sin (Jeremiah 6:15; 1 Timothy 4:2; Roman 1:18-32)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

## BEWARE BRETHREN (HEBREWS 3:7-15)



Do Not Harden Your Heart PHARAOH - Ex. 8:15 JEWS - 1 Sa. 6:6

#### How A Heart Can Become "HARD"

- Misinterpret God's Mercy / Discipline (Ex. 8:15; Rom. 2:4-5; Heb. 12:4-11)
- Think God's Will Can Be Changed to Accommodate Partial Compliance;
  Cultural Changes; or Our Personal Desires (Exodus 8:25; 10:10-11,24;
  Heb. 13:8,9; Gal. 1:6-9; 2 Pet. 3:15-18)
  - Failure To Truly Repent When Given The Opportunity (Ex 8:8, 28; 9:27-28; 10:16-17; Deut 6:12-15; Mat. 7:21-23)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...


## BEWARE BRETHREN (HEBREWS 3:7-15)



- Lest through unbelief we depart from the LORD ...
  - A believer CAN develop an EVIL HEART (2:1–3; 12:15; Prov. 4:23)
  - A believer CAN become an UNBELIEVER (1 Cor. 10:1-13)
  - A believer can DEPART from God (Gal. 5:1-7; 2 Pet. 2:20-22)
  - When a believer departs from God, getting them to return is nearly impossible (2 Pet. 2:21; Heb. 6:4-6)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

#### **BUT EXHORT ONE ANOTHER DAILY (HEBREWS 3:7-15)**



- While it is called "Today" We need to be building each other UP!
  - By caring for one another (Rom. 12:15,16; 1 Cor. 12:26)
  - By encouraging one another to remain faithful w/ God's word (Ac. 11:23; 1 Thes. 2:11; 4:18; 5:11)
  - By worshipping together (10:24,25;1 Co. 11:23-26; 14; Ep. 5:19; Col. 3:16)
  - Reproving, rebuking & correcting those in sin (2 Tim. 4:2; 1 Tim. 5:20)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

#### **BUT EXHORT ONE ANOTHER DAILY (HEBREWS 3:7-15)**



- While it is called "Today" We need to be building each other UP!
  - There is great danger in being separated from one another (3:13; Heb 10:25,26)
  - Sin is deceitful and the hardening tendencies of sin can often be counteracted by truly concerned fellow Christians (Ep. 4:22; Gal 6:1-3)
  - Encouragement is a two way street (Rom. 15:1; Gal. 6:1-3; Jam. 5:13-16)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...


#### BUT EXHORT ONE ANOTHER DAILY (HEBREWS 3:7-15)

Hebrews 3:14-15 (NKJV) 14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, 15 while it is said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."

- "Made partakers of Christ if" (3:14,15)
  - Our obtaining the promised rest (heaven) is conditioned on holding firmly to it by faithfulness (Titus 1:2; Rom 8:17-24; 1 John 2:22)
  - The Bible teaches the security of the believer (John 5:24; 6:35-40; 10:28,29; Rom 8:28-39
  - But what IF a believer becomes an unbeliever? Unbelievers will be lost (Heb 4:1,11; 6:4-6; 10:26-31; 1 Cor. 9:27; 10:1-13; Gal. 5:1-4; 2 Pet 2:20-22)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...


#### THE DANGER IS REAL (HEBREWS 3:16-19)



- For who, having heard, rebelled? (16)
  - Only two of that generation entered the promise land. The rest died in the wilderness (Num. 14:29,30; 26:64,65)
  - The promise of Canaan had been given to them - Christians also have a promise of rest - (4:1)
  - Israel did not receive the promise of rest - Christians can also fail to receive their promised rest - i.e., can be lost (4:1; 10:26-31; Acts 8:13,20-23)

# IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEART ...

#### THE DANGER IS REAL (HEBREWS 3:16-19)



- For who, having heard, rebelled? (16)
  - Israel did not enter their rest because of "unbelief" / If we become unbelievers, we will not enter our rest either (3:18,19; 4:11; 1 Cor 10:1-13)
  - The Israelites did not become atheists
     — they were disobedient (3:18,19)
     (disobedience = unbelief / obedience = belief)
  - All disobedience reflects unbelief (James 2:14-26; Luke 6:46)




# A Rest Remains

- <sup>9</sup> There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.


# A Rest Remains

<sup>2</sup> in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began.


# A Rest Remains

3... has begotten us again to a living hope . . . 4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,


# A Rest Remains


