


#### DO WE HAVE EARS TO HEAR?

<sup>9</sup> He who has ears to hear, let him hear!" (Mat 13:9)





- Some heard and accepted initial truth but failed to strengthen their convictions, thus failing to grow (13:5,6,20,21; Heb 5:12-14; 2 Pet 1:5-11)
- Some heard and accepted initial truth but allowed some worldliness to remain (13:7,22; Col. 3:5-11; Jam. 1:6,7; 4:8)
- Some heard initial truth and went on to produce much fruit & endure (13:8; Gal. 5:22,23; 2 Pet. 1:5-11; 1 Cor. 15:58)



## Acts 28:23-31 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at his lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. <sup>24</sup> And some were persuaded by the things which were spoken, and some disbelieved. <sup>25</sup> So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said one word: "The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our fathers,

## 2 Thessalonians 2:10-15 (NKJV)



## 2 Thessalonians 2:10-15 (NKJV)

13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, 14 to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast and hold the traditions which you were taught, whether by word or our epistle.






