

- This lesson is NOT about promoting a 'positive mental attitude' approach to life, but rather a balanced, informed, and godly approach to life.






Definition of Attitude

- "A settled way of thinking or feeling about someone or something, typically one that is reflected in a person's behavior."
- "Beliefs, emotions, and behaviors toward a particular object, person, thing, or event"






Components of Attitude

- Cognitive: Your thoughts and beliefs about the subject.
- Affective: How the object, person, issue, or event makes you feel.
- **Behavioral**: How attitude influences your behavior.

¹⁰ Then the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea. When they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. 11 These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so. 12 Therefore many of them believed, and also not a few of the Greeks, prominent women as well as men. 13 But when the Jews from Thessalonica learned that the word of God was preached by Paul at Berea, they came there also and stirred up the crowds.

- 1. We will not believe more than we know, and we will not live higher than our beliefs.
- 2. The many fronts of moral compromise in this generation can be directly traced to biblical illiteracy in the pews and the absence of biblical preaching and teaching in our homes and churches.

- 4."I have the Holy Spirit dwelling in me I don't need to study the Bible …"






- 1.A belief that truth is subjective & relative (no moral absolutes / doctrine & theology inconsequential) (Judg 21:25; Jer. 6:16-19)
- 2. The emphasis of feelings & emotion over, & instead of, a "thus saith the Lord." (Prov 14:12; Jer. 10:23;)
- 3.A rejection of the reliability & absolute authority of the scriptures (2 Tim 3:16,17; 2 Pet 1:19-21; Mat 24:35; Luke 21:33)










Role of Bible In U.S. Society







"Bible reading has become the religious equivalent of sound-bite journalism. When people read from the Bible they typically open it, read a brief passage without much regard for the context, and

consider the primary thought or feeling that the passage provided. If they are comfortable with it, they accept it; otherwise, they deem it interesting but irrelevant to their life, and move on. There is shockingly little growth evident in people's understanding of the fundamental themes of the scriptures and amazingly little interest in deepening their knowledge and application of biblical principles . . .

Biblical Influence In US



"The problem facing the Christian Church is not that people lack a complete set of beliefs; the problem is that they have a full slate of beliefs in mind, which they think are consistent with

biblical teachings, and they are neither open to being proven wrong nor to learning new insights. Our research suggests that this challenge initially emerges in the late adolescent or early teenage years . . . In a culture driven by the desire to receive value, more Bible teaching is generally not viewed as an exercise in providing such value."



2 Timothy 3:1–9 (NKJV)

¹ But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without selfcontrol, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!



2 Timothy 4:1-5 (NKJV)

¹ I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: ² Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. ³ For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. ⁵ But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.



2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 (NKJV)

¹⁰ and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, 12 that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

³⁹ You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and ^pthese are they which testify of Me. ⁴⁰ ^qBut you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.



John 5:39-47 (NKJV)

44 SHow can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that comes from the only God? 45 Do not think that I shall accuse you to the Father; ^uthere is one who accuses you—Moses, in whom you trust. ⁴⁶ For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; ^vfor he wrote about Me. ⁴⁷ But if you ^wdo not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?"





- MUST READ God's word: "You search the scriptures" (39)
- **MUST TRUST IN God's word**: "in them you think you have eternal life" (39)
 - MUST BE WILLING TO BELIEVE & OBEY GOD's word: "which testify of Me" (40; 7:17)
 - MUST FEAR, LOVE & SEEK TO HONOR GOD: "44How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that *comes* from the only God?" (41-44; Mat. 15:1-9;)





- They Wanted To Learn [. . . all the people gathered together as one man] (Neh. 8:1)
- They gave God's word their undivided attention [all the people were attentive to the Book of the Law] (Neh. 8:3)
- They demonstrated respect for God's word [which they had made for the purpose . . . when he opened it, all the people stood up] (Neh. 8:4,5)
- They sought accurate understanding [they understood the words that were declared to them] (Neh. 8:12)
- They repented and obeyed it [For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the Law] (Neh. 8:9)

- Be Active & Supportive Of The Church and the proclamation of God's word -Heb 10:24,25; Col 1:28,29; 4:2-4




- The importance of establishing Divine authority for ALL we do.

- Will we seek to share our faith Eph 4:15; I Thes 1:8






In order to be pleasing to God, we must have an attitude of complete trust & surrender.
