






Definition of Attitude








Components of Attitude

- Cognitive: Your thoughts and beliefs about the subject.
- Affective: How the object, person, issue, or event makes you feel.
- **Behavioral**: How attitude influences your behavior.


Psalm 36:title-4 (NKJV)


WHAT IS MY ATTITUDE TOWARDS SIN?




Proverbs 22:3-5 (NKJV)



GOD HATES SIN & SO SHOULD WE




WE SHOULD HATE SIN BECAUSE

- It dishonors God & separates us from Him (Ps. 5:4–6; Is. 59:1,2; I John 1:5,6)
- It is destructive to us personally in this life and potentially forever (Rom. 2:5-11; Mat. 25:41,46; Rev. 21:8)
- It destroys relationships & is harmful to those around us (Gen. 4; Josh. 7; 2 Sam. 11:12; Gal. 5:9; 2 Tim. 2:17)
- Jesus came to this world, lived, suffered & was crucified because of our sin.



GOD HATES SIN & SO SHOULD WE




Romans 5:6–8 (NKJV)

⁶ For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.






REPENTANCE - A CHANGE OF MIND


FIVE R's of REPENTANCE

- Remorseful (i.e. Regret & Grieve Over Sin)
- Resolve
 (i.e. Purpose, Determined in Mind)
- Reform

 (i.e. Change Your Lifestyle)
- Restore (i.e. Make Amends If Possible)

REPENTANCE IN PRACTICE ...

Ephesians 5:1–17 (NKJV)

- ⁶ Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. ⁷ Therefore do not be partakers with them.
- ⁸ For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), ¹⁰ finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. ¹¹ And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but

rather expose them.



REPENTANCE IN PRACTICE ...

Ephesians 5:1–17 (NKJV)

¹² For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. 13 But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light. 14 Therefore He says: "Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light." 15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, ¹⁶ redeeming the time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is.



REPENTANCE IN PRACTICE ...

Colossians 3:1-11 (NKJV)

¹ If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ² Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. ³ For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. 5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.




REPENTANCE IN PRACTICE ...

Colossians 3:1-11 (NKJV)

⁶ Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, ⁷ in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. 8 But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, 10 and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him ...

- THINGS THAT PREVENT A

 - ➤ ACCEPTANCE of FALSE





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Amos 5:3–15 (NKJV)

³ For thus says the Lord God: "The city that goes out by a thousand Shall have a hundred left, And that which goes out by a hundred Shall have ten left to the house of Israel." 4 For thus says the Lord to the house of Israel: "Seek Me and live; 5 But do not seek Bethel, Nor enter Gilgal, Nor pass over to Beersheba; For Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, And Bethel shall come to nothing. ⁶ Seek the Lord and live, Lest He break out like fire in the house of Joseph, And devour it, With no one to quench it in Bethel

Amos 5:3–15 (NKJV)

— ⁷ You who turn justice to wormwood, And lay righteousness to rest in the earth!" 8 He made the Pleiades and Orion; He turns the shadow of death into morning And makes the day dark as night; He calls for the waters of the sea And pours them out on the face of the earth; The Lord is His name. 9 He rains ruin upon the strong, So that fury comes upon the fortress. ¹⁰ They hate the one who rebukes in the gate, And they abhor the one who speaks uprightly.

Amos 5:3-15 (NKJV)

11 Therefore, because you tread down the poor And take grain taxes from him, Though you have built houses of hewn stone, Yet you shall not dwell in them; You have planted pleasant vineyards, But you shall not drink wine from them. 12 For I know your manifold transgressions And your mighty sins: Afflicting the just and taking bribes; Diverting the poor from justice at the gate. 13 Therefore the prudent keep silent at that time, For it is an evil time. 14 Seek good and not evil, That you may live; So the Lord God of hosts will be with you, As you have spoken. 15 Hate evil, love good; Establish justice in the gate.
