


THINGS PERTAINING TO LIFE & GODLINESS (1:3)

- BE PREPARED for the "DAY of the LORD" by living holy lives (3:10-13)


2 Peter 3:14–18 (NKJV)

14 Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; 15 and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation—as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you, 16 as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.

2 Peter 3:14–18 (NKJV)

17 You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; 18 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.

"ANOTHER CALL TO "DILIGENCE" (3:14)



- "Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things"
 - Therefore seeing these things will happen (10-13)
 - Looking forward let the future certainty of "the day of the Lord" motivate us to be ready (Acts 17:30; Rom. 2:5-11; 2 Cor. 5:10; 1 Jno. 3:3.)

"ANOTHER CALL TO "DILIGENCE" (3:14)



- "be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless;"
 - "be diligent" twice before cf. 2 Peter 1:5,10 — means "earnestness, zeal, or with haste" (1 Cor. 15:58)
 - "to be found by Him in peace" when the Lord comes we had better be right with God! (Mat. 24:46)
 - "without spot & blameless" Faithful, unspotted from the world. The result of diligence (1:5-10; 1 Th. 3:13; 5:23; 1 Tim. 6:14; Ja 1:27; 1 Jn 1:7; Eph. 5:25-27)

"HEED THE EPISTLES OF PAUL" (3:15,16)

2 Peter 3:15–16 (NKJV)

15 and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation -as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you, ¹⁶ as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things,...

- "and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation"
 - Paul also wrote of God's longsuffering and desire to save us — (Rom. 2:4. 1 Tim. 1:16)
 - Paul also wrote by divine wisdom from God [i.e., inspiration] (1 Co. 2:13; 12:8; Gal. 1:11,12; Ep. 3:3-5)

2 Peter 3:15–16 (NKJV) in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable *people* twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.

- "and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation"
 - Paul also wrote of God's longsuffering and desire to save us — (Rom. 2:4. 1 Tim. 1:16)
 - Paul also wrote by divine wisdom from God [i.e., inspiration] (1 Co. 2:13; 12:8; Gal. 1:11,12; Ep. 3:3-5)
 - Paul's writings were not easy for some to understand (Eph. 3:1-10)
 - Paul's writings are "scripture" (Acts 26:16; 1 Cor. 2:13; 2 Tim. 3:15-17; etc.)

"HEED THE EPISTLES OF PAUL" (3:15,16)

2 Peter 3:15–16 (NKJV) in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable *people* twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.

- "which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction"
 - The writings of Paul were / are "twisted" by others to teach error (Acts 21:21,28; Rom. 3:7,8; 6:1,15; 7:7)
 - The "untaught" lack knowledge, yet they believe they are ready to "do battle." "A little" knowledge can be dangerous. (Jude 10)
 - "Unstable" are those not grounded and are thus easily persuaded to accept error and evil (cf. 2:14; Eph. 4:14; 2 Tim. 2:14-18)

"HEED THE EPISTLES OF PAUL" (3:15,16)

2 Peter 3:15–16 (NKJV) in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable *people* twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.

- "which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction"
 - The false doctrine of salvation by faith alone is often attributed to Paul due to a misunderstanding of passages such as Romans 4; Ephesians 2:1-10; Titus 3:5 etc.
 - False teachers misuse his teaching regarding the security of the faithful to mean O.S.A.S (Rom. 8:28-39)
 - A misunderstanding of Romans 9 has led some to teach the false doctrine of "Unconditional Election"

SUMMARY EXHORTATIONS (17-18)

2 Peter 3:17–18 (NKJV) 17 You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked;

- "beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness"
 - If we know the truth and hold tightly to it we will not be led astray (3:17; Eph. 4:12-15; Rom. 8)
 - The danger is real not imaginary (1:8-10; 2:20-22; Rom. 11:20,21; 14:15,20; 1 Cor. 10:1-13; Gal. 5:1-4)
 - Therefore do not allow the schemes and tactics of false teachers lead you away from the truth as taught in the scriptures (Rom. 3:4; Aacts 17:11,12)

SUMMARY EXHORTATIONS (17-18)

2 Peter 3:17–18 (NKJV) but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.

- "but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (18)
 - We can avoid being deceived and falling away from the Lord by giving all diligence to grow (1:5-10)
 - Growing in grace is accomplished through strengthening and exercising our faith (1:3, 5-10; Eph. 2:5-10; 1 Cor. 15:58; Col. 1:19-23)
 - Growing in knowledge (or understanding) will enable us to recognize error and truth (Co 1:9,10)

SUMMARY EXHORTATIONS (17-18)


