Deuteronomy 30:11-20 (NKJV)

11 "For this commandment which I command you today is not too mysterious for you, nor is it far off. 12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 13 Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 14 But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it.




Principles (Inat Should Govern How We Make Our Decisions



Decisions that dishonor God are governed by:


- Pride / Selfishness (Pr. 21:4; Jam. 4:3)
- Prioritizing temporal possessions, pleasures, success (Lk. 18:18-25)
- Human wisdom / tradition (Mat. 15:7-9; Col. 2:8; Jam 3:13-16)
- Bad theology / doctrine (Acts 17:22,23; Gal. 1:6,7; 5:1-4)
- Our emotions [Never make a permanent decision because of a temporary problem] (Pr. 14:12; Je. 10:23)






Decisions that HONOR God are governed by:

- Humility / Love (Jam. 4:6-10; Mk 12:29-31; Rom. 13:8)
- Prioritizing spiritual things (Col. 1:1,2)
- Divine wisdom / tradition (I Cor 1:18-25; Jam. 3:13,17-18; 2 Th. 2:15)
- Correct theology / doctrine (Acts 17:24-31; Jn 8:32; 1 Tim. 4:13-16)
- Appealing to the objective standard of God's word (Rom 3:4; 2 Tim. 3:16,17; Heb 5:12-14)





² Also it is not good for a soul to be without knowledge, And he sins who hastens with his feet.








