

⁶ Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.




Your acceptance or rejection of your duties as a parent will be your real legacy —

If we do NOT train our children — the world will!








Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

- Children are a heritage of the Lord (Ps. 127:3)
- Stewardship implies responsibility (1 Sam 2:29, 31-34; 3:13)
- Being a good steward takes effort (Lk 12:42,43)
- Too many parents live with the regret and pain of failing their children!

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 (NKJV)

⁶ "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.


Judges 2:10–13 (NKJV)




Ephesians 6:1–4 (NKJV)

ST POINT OF EMPHASIS




Teach Them How To Love By Loving (Deut. 6:4,5; Titus 2:4)

- To love them is to value them to seek their best interest (our true values will be seen in what we seek for our children) (Jn 3:16; I Cor 13:8-10)
- Love them by teaching them to love God by loving God (Deut 6:4,5; Mark 12:29-30; Rom. 8:28; I Jn 5:4)
- Love them by teaching them to love others (brethren / neighbor / less fortunate / enemies (Jn 13:34; Ep. 5:2; Mk 12:31; Mat 25: 40; 5:44)

POINT OF EMPHASIS


Teach Them God's Word (Deut. 6:6-9; Eph. 3:5; 1 Pet 2:2)



- Begin teaching them what the scriptures say early (2 Tim 3:15)
- Teach them "diligently" keeping it before them at all times (Dt 6:7,8)
- Teach them how to apply the scriptures correctly (2 Tim. 2:15)
- Help them develop their own faith (evidences / history / etc.) (Rom. 10:17)
- Teach them by living it (Dt 6:7-9; Gen 18:19; Mat 5:13-16)



Discipline Them Properly - (Eph. 6:4; Prov. 13:24; 19:18; 22:15; 23:13)



- This includes positive teaching and training (teaching them to respect authority especially God's / teach them how to work and serve) (Psalm 34:11-14; Prov 3:1-7; Ecc 12:13)
- Teach them to think correctly (discerning right from wrong / develop godly attitude) (Prov 4:1-27)
- Punish disobedience (Prov. 13:24; 22:15; 23:13,14; 29:15,17; Heb 12:7-9)


TH POINT OF EMPHASIS



Teach Them To Reverence & Worship God (John 4:24; Heb. 12:25-29)

- Teach them to reverence God the importance of following God's instructions as given (Lev 10:3; Col. 3:17; Heb 12:28; 2 Jn 9)
- Teach them the value and importance of assembling with the saints (Psalm 122:1; Heb 10:24,25)
- Teach them the importance and value of godliness in every aspect of life (Ro. 12:1,2; 2 Cor. 6:14-7:1; 1 The 5:17)

TH POINT OF EMPHASIS




Teach Them To Reverence & Worship God (John 4:24; Heb. 12:25-29)

- By consistently attending every service punctuality
- Teaching them to be quiet listen to the lessons stay seated
- Teaching them to participate in the worship (singing / praying /etc.)
- Training them to take part in the work of the church -


TH POINT OF EMPHASIS

Regulate Their Friends (Prov. 13:20; 1 Cor. 15:33)



- Do not be deceived into thinking that worldly friends will not negatively influence your child (Prov. 1:10-15; 4:14; Ps. 1:1; 1 Cor 15:33)
- Children may see it as intrusive, especially in the teenage years, but it is necessary it is your duty to protect them (same principle as in 1 Cor. 5, a little leaven leavens the whole) (Eph. 5:11; 2 Cor. 6:14)






Teach them danger of sin and error

(Prov. 5:1-11, 21-23; Isa. 9:16)

- Teach them actions have consequences and that sin has its consequences (Gal. 6:7-9; Gen. 3; Prov. 5; 7:6-27; Rom. 6:23)
- Children must learn that sin and false doctrine is often appealing and always deceitful (Gen. 3; He. 3:12,13; Mt 7:15)
- Being grounded in the truth is a MUST, which includes MANY warnings of how sin & false teachers operate (1 Cor. 10:1-13; 2 Pet. 2; 3:1618)


POINT OF EMPHASIS



Teach Them How To Represent Christ

(Mat. 5:13-16; Phili. 2:14-16)

- Consistent godly living (word / deed / appearance) (Phil. 2:14-16; Rom 2:17-24)
- Kindness, goodness, mercy, obedience, LOVE (Ti. 2:14; Co. 3:12-16; Gal. 5:22,23)
- Patient and confident in trials and suffering (Acts 4:8-13; 5:29-31; 1 Pet 3:13-17; Jam. 1:3-17)
- Teaching about Jesus in word and deed (Act 8:4; I Thes. I:8)




