


Colossians 3:14-17 (NKJV)


Name - onoma (3686)


onoma (ὄνομα, 3686) "is used (I) in general of the name by which a person or thing is called.... (II) for all that a name implies, of authority, character, rank, majesty, power, excellence, etc., of everything that the name covers: also the phrases rendered 'in the name;' these may be analysed as follows: (1) representing the authority of Christ.... (2) in the power of.... (3) in acknowledgement or confession of.... (4) in recognition of the authority of (sometimes combined with the thought of relying or resting on)...Col. 3:17; (Bold emphasis mine, #3686, pp. 771-772)



CONTEXT DETERMINES MEANING




- "Seek those things which are above where Christ sits ..." (1).

- Hebrews 1:2 ² has in these last days spoken to us by *His* Son


THE AUTHORITY OF JESUS



Philippians 2:9–11 (NKJV)

⁹ Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

[7] ... By what **power**, or by what **name**, have ye done this?


[10] ... by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, . . . even by him . . .

[20] For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.


SUBMITTING TO JESUS'S AUTHORITY



2 John 9-11 (NKJV)

⁹ Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son. 10 If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him; ¹¹ for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds.



- The way of salvation
 - Hear (Rom. 10:13-17)
 - **Believe** (John 3:16-18; 8:24; Acts 8:37; Rom. 10:9,10)
 - Repent (Lk 13:3,5; Acts 17:30)
 - Confess (Matt. 10:32; Luke 12:8; Rom. 10:9,10)
 - Baptism in the name of Christ (Mat. 28:18,19; Mark 16:15,16; Acts 2:38; 8:12-16; 10:43,47,48; Rom. 6:1-18; 10:1-17)


"Pray this prayer asking Jesus to come into your heart and save you"

Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.' (Acts 22:16)








- What is taught & preached

 - Doctrines of men forbidden (Mat. 15:7-9; Col. 2:18–22; Titus 1:14)




- Things that CANNOT be taught in the name of JESUS

 - Premillennialism



Worshipping in the name of Jesus


- Edification (1 Cor. 14)

DEEDS IN THE NAME OF JESUS



- Things CALLED worship which CANNOT be done in the name of Jesus
 - Teaching error / secular
 - Praying through Mary ...
 - Fundraisers / secular activities
 - Social meals / ignore L.S.
 - Mechanical instrumental music / entertainment

SUBMITTING TO JESUS'S AUTHORITY



- A Matter of **HUMILITY** (Mt 5:3; cf. Deut. 8:2; James 4:6-10)
- A matter of **FAITH** (Jn 3:18; Ac 10:43; 1Jn 5:13; Ro. 10:17)
- A Matter of **RESPECT** (Isaiah 66:2; Lk 6:46-47; He. 12:25–29)
- A Matter of **LOVE** (Jn 14:15, 21, 23-24; 1 Jn 5:2,3)
