The word angel *angelos* (ἄγγελος, 32), **Lit. messenger**

- Luke 7:24 (NKJV) When the <u>messengers</u> of John had departed,
- Luke 9:52 (NKJV) and sent
 <u>messengers</u> before His



Background Information of Ephesus


- Ephesus was an illustrious city in its day, capital of the Roman province of Asia with a population of about 250,000. An important commercial city.
- Magical arts were prevalent in Ephesus as evidenced by the number and value of books burned -(19:19)
 - The temple erected to the goddess Diana $\{Artemis\}$ an entire industry had grown up around it, making and selling idols & "portable shrines." (19:23-41)

- 4 times larger than the Parthenon in Athens
- Under construction in 333 BC when Alexander the Great arrived.

- Paul's first visit Acts 18:19
- Aquila & Priscilla corrects Apollos in Ephesus – Act 18:24-28
- Paul returns to Ephesus: baptizes 12, teaches for 2 years in the school of Tyrannus; Riot / Many burned their books - Acts 19


Paul returns staying 3 years – Acts 20:31

Book of Ephesians written by Paul from prison in about 61 or 62 AD

Revelation 2:1 (NKJV) "To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands:

SALUTATION

- Address to the messenger of the church of Ephesus in writing.
- Jesus holds the destiny of the church in His hands.
- Jesus walks in their midst, i.e., He is fully aware of what they are doing.
- Jesus is concerned about their spiritual welfare.

Revelation 2:2 (NKJV)
² "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;

COMMENDATION

Labor – Toiled & sacrificed to carry out the work of God



- **Patience** not giving up when things got tough -
- Intolerant of those who would not conform to the teachings of Jesus Christ. (2 John 1:10-11)

Revelation 2:2 (NKJV)

COMMENDATION

Examined to prove – those claiming to be apostles (Acts 17:11,12; 1 John 4:1; 2 Cor. 12:12)



Exposed – them for who and what they really were (2 Cor. 11:13)



Identified error — not
 contrary to love (2 Jn 6-11

COMMENDATION

- Endurance through trials
 & persecutions (James 1:2-4)
- Toiled in magnifying the authority of the Lord Jesus Christ, i.e., Holding Him up as LORD (Col. 3:17)
 - Relentless they labored,
 without tiring from serving
 the Lord. (Gal 6:9; Heb 12:3)



COMMENDATION

Hate? – The Lord hates false doctrine and deeds that spring forth from false doctrine



Hate? – We should hate the same things the Lord hates. (Ps. 26:5; 101:3; 139:21,22)

COMPLAINT / REBUKE

- Seven glowing commendations, BUT, just one complaint is one too many! (James 2:10)
- They had "left their first love" Something they previously had (Acts 19:19,20; 20:36-38; Ep 1:15)

Revelation 2:4 (NKJV) ⁴ Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love.

COMPLAINT / REBUKE

- They had had a change in their values, priorities, and motives – The Lord demands service & obedience from a pure and wholly devoted heart. (Mark 12:29-31; Ro 6:17,18; 1 Jn 5:3)
- Mechanical routine, even if proper in its outward form, will not please God! (Mat 23:23; 1 Cor 13:13)

Revelation 2:4 (NKJV) ⁴ Nevertheless I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love.

COMPLAINT / REBUKE

- Correct actions are
 worthless if our motives are
 not genuine & pure (Ps
 51:16,17; Isa. 1:11-17;
 Micah 6:6-8; 1 Cor. 13:1-3)
- The Lord does not only look at what we do but also takes note of our intent & motives (1 Sam 16:7)

Revelation 2:5 (NKJV)

WARNING & EXHORTATION

- **Remember** Virtue of Recall – Luke 15:17-21; Eph 1:3-14
- Honesty self investigation 2 Cor. 13:5



- **Repent** Change of mind / heart (Acts 17:30)
- Return put the Lord first / His will / His work / His purposes (Mark 12:29-31)


