

James 2:14-26 (NKJV)

14 What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? 17 Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. 18 But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

James 2:14–26 (NKJV)

¹⁹ You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble! 20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? ²¹ Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? 22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?

²³ And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God. 24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only. ²⁵ Likewise, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out another way? ²⁶ For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.




Defining Faith




4102. πίστις pistis, pis´-tis; from 3982;

"...used especially of the faith by which a man embraces Jesus, i.e., a conviction, full of joyful trust, that Jesus is the Messiah -- the divinely appointed author of eternal salvation in the kingdom of God, conjoined with obedience to Christ."

(Thayer's Greek-English Lexicon, p. 511)




- FAITH (N) **pistis** (πίστις, 4102), "faith," is translated "belief" (2 Thess. 2:13).
- BELIEVE (V) **pisteuo** (πιστεύω, 4100), "to believe," also "to be persuaded of," and hence, "to place confidence in, to trust," signifies, in this sense of the word, reliance upon, not mere credence.
 - BELIEVER (ADJ.) **pistos** (πιστός, 4103), (a) in the active sense means "believing, trusting"; (b) in the passive sense, "trusty, faithful, trustworthy."



FAITH CANNOT SAVE THOSE WHO DO NOT OBEY!

James 2:15–17 (NKJV)

¹⁵ If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? ¹⁷ Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS NO MORE ACTUAL FAITH THAN LOVE WITHOUT WORKS IS ACTUAL LOVE!

FAITH CANNOT SAVE THOSE WHO DO NOT OBEY!

James 2:17 (NKJV) 17 Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

What does it profit?

- Hearers but not doers? (1:22-25)
- Believers who will not confess? (John 12:42; Rom. 10:9,10)
- Professors who will not obey? (Luke 6:46; Mat 7:21-23)
- Is it saving faith if it will not confess? repent? be baptized? (Luke 7:7:29,30; Heb. 11; 2 Thes. 1:7-9)



FAITH CANNOT SAVE THOSE WHO DO NOT OBEY!

James 2:18 (NKJV)

But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

What does it profit?


- Faith and works are both insufficient "ALONE!"
- A verbal declaration of faith (that is not evidenced by obedience) is a false declaration: A DEAD FAITH!
- Dead faith is counterfeit faith and lulls the person into a false confidence, i.e., he deceives himself (1:22)

FAITH CANNOT SAVE THOSE WHO DO NOT OBEY!

James 2:19 (NKJV) 19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believeand tremble!

- Demons believe in the one true God (Mk 1:24; 5:7; Lk 4:34; Ac. 19:15)
- Demons believe in the deity of Jesus (Mark 3:11,12; Luke 8:30,31)
- Demons believe in hell (Mt 8:29)
- Demons believe Jesus is judge and will condemn (Mark 5:1-13)


FAITH THAT OBEYS IS THE FAITH THAT SAVES!



James 2:21 (NKJV)
Was not Abraham our
father justified by works
when he offered Isaac

- Abraham was JUSTIFIED by works (justified, [dikaiosune δικαιοσύνη] same term as in Rom 4:2,3,5,6; 6:16)
- Abraham trusted God to the max when he obeyed God by offering Isaac! (Heb 11:17; Rom 4:19-22; Gen 22:1-19)

James 2:23 (NKJV)


²³ And the Scripture was fulfilled which says,

"Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness."

And he was called the friend of God.

- Faith motivated his obedience, which rendered his faith complete, therefore effectual (22; Heb 11:17-19; Gal 5:6)
- Faith was credited to Abraham as righteousness when he obeyed! (23a; Gen 15:6; Rom 4:3; Gal. 3:6-8)
- Abraham was called the friend of God! (23b; Is 41:8; 2 Chron 20:7)





James 2:23 (NKJV)

²³ And the Scripture was fulfilled which says,

"Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness."

And he was called the friend of God.

James 2:24 (NKJV)

24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.



FAITH THAT OBEYS IS THE FAITH THAT SAVES!



- Listed among the heroes of faith (Heb 11:31)
- ▶ Great grandmother of David and in the lineage of Jesus (Mat 1:5,6)
- She helped the spies escape at the risk of her own life! (Joshua 2:10,11)
- ▶ When Jericho was destroyed she, & her household were saved (Josh 6:25; Heb 11:31)



What About Ephesians 2:8,9?

Ephesians 2:8–9 (NKJV)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

- Salvation is a gift of God which no man deserves (Rom 3:23)
- Salvation is received through the faith by the means of our faith (John 3:16; 8:24; Heb 11:6; Rom 1:16,17; 10:17)
- Salvation CANNOT BE earned through our own merits (Rom. 11:6)
- No man can boast before God (Rom. 4:2; 3:23)



What About Ephesians 2:8,9?

Ephesians 2:8–9 (NKJV)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

- Noah saved by grace through faith − Gen. 6:8;
 Heb 11:7
- Naaman healed by grace through faith − 2 Kings 5:1-19; Lk 4:27
- Walls of Jericho fell by grace through faith − Joshua 6:2,15,16,20; Heb 11:30
- The FAITH that obeys does not nullify God's grace but receives it!!

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

FAITH THAT OBEYS IS THE FAITH THAT SAVES!




- Faith without works is useless

- Faith without works is dead




- We are NOT saved by faith ALONE!

WE CANNOT BE SAVED WITHOUT OBEYING THE LORD BY FAITH














Matthew 7:21–27 (NKJV)
