



The tongue is small but ... Like a small bit or rudder ... Like a small fire that can spread out of control and destroy much Can defile and destroy us and our relationships,



# WATCH YOUR MADUTTH

## Can Cause MUCH TROUBLE - 3:6

- "World of iniquity" stirs up sin (Prov 26:21)
- Defiles the whole body. (Mt 12:34-35)
- "Sets on fire the course (wheel) of nature" can consume all aspects of one's life - and destroy those nearby.
  - "Is set on fire of hell" the source of the deadly fire is hell itself (lit., "Gehenna,")


### **James 3:7–8 (NKJV)** <sup>7</sup> For every kind of beast and bird, of

### **BUT CAN BE CONTROLLED**





- In order for polluted water to come out of a faucet, the water in the tank, (source), must be polluted!
- Our words come from our thoughts.





**A HEART ISSUE** 

<sup>11</sup> The mouth of the righteous *is* a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked. <sup>12</sup> Hatred stirs up strife, But love covers all sins. <sup>13</sup> Wisdom is found on the lips of him who has understanding, But a rod is for the back of him who is devoid of understanding. <sup>14</sup> Wise *people* store up knowledge, But the mouth of the foolish *is* near destruction.


