
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



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"Among the Jews, Sophos ("wise") was a technical term for the teacher, the scribe, the Rabbi" (Theological Dictionary of the New Testament. 7:505)

Jewish disciples wanted to be teachers (3:1)

James is still dealing with the tongue - but goes beyond the sins of the tongue to the source of those sins.

### What qualifications should one meet to be a teacher? (cf. Deut 1:13)


- Wisdom in handling the scriptures (2 Tim 2:15; 2 Pet. 3:16-18)
- Wisdom in handling difficult situations would be important (Jude 1:22,23; James 1:5)
- Wisdom is necessary in promoting unity & harmony (Jam 3:13-18)



## TWO KINDS OF WISDON Heavenly? ... or Earthly, Sensual, Demonic? Defining Wisdom

**Thayer Definition:** G4678 – σοφία - sophia 1) wisdom, broad and full of intelligence; used of the knowledge of very diverse matters - 1a) ... acquired by acuteness and experience, ... 1a5) skill in the management of affairs - 1a6) devout and proper prudence ... 1a7) the knowledge and practice of the requisites for godly and upright living





## VO KINDS OF WISDOM Heavenly? ... or Earthly, Sensual, Demonic? Defining Wisdom

**VINE'S Definition:** sophia (oopia,4678) is used with reference to (a) God, ... (b) Christ, ... (c) "wisdom" personified, ... (d) human "wisdom" "Sophia is the insight into the true nature of things,"

Meekness - the opposite of arrogance -(Mat 20:25-28; Gal. 6:1; 1 Tim 6:11)



- Not ONLY WORDS but also DEEDS
- "Good conversation" (KJV); "good conduct" (NKJV); "good behavior" - (NASB) - (cf. Eph 5:15-17; 1 Tim 4:12-16)
  - Works (Mt 7:24; Tit 2:14 in contrast cf. Mat. 6:1-18; 23:2-5; Tit 1:16)





James 3:14 (NKJV) <sup>14</sup> But if you have <u>bitter</u> envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.

"Bitter envying" - (2) pert. to being bitter in feeling or attitude, bitter, embittered, harsh, [BDAG] — "an envious and contentious rivalry, jealousy" (Thayer. 271) An intense feeling due to perceived wrongs resulting in an intense, cynical, antagonism, which translates into open hostility toward others.









James 3:14 (NKJV) <sup>14</sup> But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.

I Cor 3:3 - For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?




Galatians 5:20 - . . . contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

Rom. 13:13 - Let us walk properly . . . not in strife and envy.





James 3:14 (NKJV) <sup>14</sup> But if you have <u>bitter</u> envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. "Self seeking" - "faction" (ASV), "strife -(KJV), "selfish ambition" (NASB), -"denotes ambition, self-seeking, rivalry, self-will being an underlying idea in the word; denotes party-making" (Vine. 2:68). One who is interested in promoting self over the needs of others or wellbeing of the whole; creating division & parties.





#### WISDOM FROM ABOVE IS NEITHER ENVIOUS OR SELFISH ...

James 3:14 (NKJV)14 But if you havebitter envy andself-seeking inyour hearts, do notboast and lieagainst the truth.

<sup>1</sup> Therefore if *there is* any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, <sup>2</sup> fulfill my joy by being likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. <sup>3</sup> Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

#### Philippians 2:1–5 (NKJV)





James 3:15 (NKJV) <sup>15</sup> This wisdom does not descend from above, but *is* earthly, sensual, demonic.

- Origin: "Earthly" "... the wisdom of man, liable to error and misleading" - (Thayer. 236-7). (cf. Phili. 3:18-20)
- Wisdom that is according to the world's standards, lusts, and goals.
- Such limited understanding cannot be relied upon and is foolishness to God (cf. -1 Cor 1:20-24,25.26; 2 Cor. 4:4; 1 John 2:15)





**James 3:15** (NKJV) 15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic.

Appeal: "Sensual" - ". . . principle of animal life, which men have in common with the brutes. b. governed by the... sensuous nature with its subjection to appetite and passion" (Thayer. 677-8). - cf. Jude 17-19 Appealing to the senses, the emotions, the passions — resulting in the increase of carnality and the decrease of spirituality!





**James 3:15** (NKJV) 15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic.



- Nature: "devilish" "resembling or proceeding from an evil spirit, demonlike" (Thayer. 124) - cf. John 8:44
- Does not require denial of God & spiritual things, just a promotion of worldly, carnal & sensual things above the spiritual.
  - Satan did not seek to make Eve an atheist, but to demote God in her mind (Gen 3)




**James 3:16** (NKJV) <sup>16</sup> For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.

Confusion - "instability..., denotes a state of disorder, disturbance, confusion, tumult ... revolution or anarchy" (Vine. 1:227)

Every evil work - worthless, vile, wicked, base — "for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?" (1 Cor. 3:3)







<sup>17</sup> But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

  - Maturity Heb 5:14





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
## **NATURE OF WISDOM FROM ABOVE:**



Pure - "not contaminated" (Vine. 3:231); cf. Mat 5:8; 1 John 3:3; Gal 1:8-9

Peaceable - cf. Matthew 5:9

Gentle - "equitable, fair, moderate, forbearing, considerateness - looks reasonably at the facts (cf. Phil 4:5)






<sup>17</sup> But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

## **NATURE OF WISDOM FROM ABOVE:**

- Willing to yield Does not yield faith but opinions - considers the evidence & yields to the truth
- Mercy kindness or good will towards the miserable and afflicted, joined with a desire to relieve them - cf. Mat 5:7





<sup>17</sup> But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

## NATURE OF WISDOM FROM ABOVE:

Good fruits - fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-24); works (Eph. 2:10); Both in the heart and in the life; two of which are immediately specified;







- Without partiality cf. James 2:1
- Without hypocrisy genuine, sincere





**James 3:18** (NKJV) <sup>18</sup> Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

#### **RESULT OF HEAVENLY WISDOM:**

- The **fruit of righteousness** is sown (Ephesians 2:10)
- In **peace** [as much as depends on us] (Romans 12:18)
- By them that make peace (cf. Mat. 5:9; Rom. 5:1; 1:16-17; Eph. 4:1-3; Phili. 4:7)



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Philippians 3:15–21 (NKJV) <sup>15</sup> Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you. 16 Nevertheless, to the degree that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind. <sup>17</sup> Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.
