

- OUR ATTITUDE: "Our beliefs, emotions, and behaviors toward a particular object, person, thing, or event"






WHATIS "THE WORLD?"




## A Person Can Be Worldly & be a "GOOD PERSON"

- Moral, benevolent, dependable, religious BUT if Not In Christ WORLDLY NOT Spiritual! (Rom 8:1-12; Mat 7:21-23; 15:7-9)
- If any man is IN CHRIST he is a new creature / sanctified / called out of the world / set apart (1 Cor. 3:18; 2 Cor 5:17-19; 6:14-7:1; Eph 1:3; Gal 3:26,27; 6:14)




#### 1 John 2:15-17 (NKJV)

15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life —is not of the Father but is of the world. <sup>17</sup> And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.




#### Romans 12:1–2 (NKJV)

#### Colossians 3:1-4 (NKJV)

## A TOWARD WORLD / HEAVEN

#### THE WORLD = SPHERE OF INIQUITY

#### Ephesians 2:1–3 (NKJV)

1 ... who were dead in trespasses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, <sup>3</sup> among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

#### 1 Corinthians 6:9–11 (NKJV)


<sup>9</sup> Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, <sup>10</sup> nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. <sup>11</sup> And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

#### THE WORLD = SPHERE OF INIQUITY


#### Galatians 5:19–21 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, <sup>21</sup> envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.



#### James 3:14–16 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. <sup>15</sup> This wisdom does not descend from above, but *is* earthly, sensual, demonic. <sup>16</sup> For where envy and self-seeking *exist*, confusion and every evil thing *are* there.




#### 2 John 9–10 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son. <sup>10</sup> If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him;

#### 1 Corinthians 3:18–20 (NKJV)


<sup>18</sup> Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. <sup>19</sup> For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, "*He catches the wise in their own craftiness*"; <sup>20</sup> and again, "*The Lord* knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."



#### Colossians 2:8 (NKJV)

8 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.


#### THE WORLD = SPHERE OF INIQUITY



- Desensitizes to sin (Eccl. 5:1; Rom 8:5; 1 Cor. 2:14)
- Separates from God (Isa. 59:1-2; Rom. 8:7,8; James 4:4)
- Hardens the heart (Mat. 13:15; Heb. 3:8,13)
- Causes **Suffering** in this life (Prov. 13:15; Jer. 2:19; Rom. 6:21)
- Results in eternal **Condemnation** (Rom. 6:23; Gal. 5:19-21; Rev. 21:8)




#### Matthew 6:19-24 (NKJV)




#### Matthew 6:19-24 (NKJV)






#### Matthew 6:25–32 (NKJV)


## SATAN'S GREATEST ADVANTAGE ...




#### Matthew 6:33–34 (NKJV)




#### Hebrews 12:1–2 (NKJV)

- LOVE: Putting God first and loving others motivates acceptable obedience (Mark 12:29-31; Mat. 6:33; Jn 14:23)




#### WE CAN HAVE VICTORY OVER THE WORLD

- For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.
  - Not to continue to sin (Ps. 119:11; Rom. 6; 1 Jn 3:1-10; 1 Thes. 5:21,22)
  - Separate from world (2 Cor. 6:14-17; James 1:27)
  - Holy / Pure / Godly (1 Pet. 1:15-16; 4:1-3; 1 Jn 3:3)



#### Galatians 6:7–9 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. <sup>8</sup> For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. <sup>9</sup> And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.
