Revelation 4:1-11 (NKJV)

¹ After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this." ² Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne. ³ And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.


Revelation 4:1-11 (NKJV)

⁴ Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads. ⁵ And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. ⁶ Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. ⁷ The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.

Revelation 4:1-11 (NKJV)

8 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" 9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11 "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- The imagery and symbols in Revelation are necessary in comprehending the BIG PICTURE but if we focus too much on the imagery and symbols we can easily MISS the BIG PICTURE.
- The BIG PICTURE in chapters 4 & 5 is clearly GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY, GLORY and how HE IS WORTHY of WORSHIP.

¹ After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this."

- The invitation (4:1): With the clarion ring of a trumpet (Exod. 19:16,19), John was beckoned to come see from heaven's point of view things that would soon happen on earth.
- Before John is shown what will happen on earth, he gets a glimpse of God's glory and the glory of the heavenly realm.
- A vision of God's celestial throne is in keeping with the prophetic tradition of the OT (Isa. 6:1; Ezek. 1:26; Dan. 7:9).

¹ After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this."

- The series of visions which are to follow, are preceded by two very special visions, 1) of God and 2) of Christ, in all of their heavenly majesty, splendor, and power.
- At the time of writing, God and Christ may have seemed to be very far removed from the earth and its inhabitants,
- Suffering saints are provided reassurance and encouragement by being assured that God and Christ are aware of their tribulations; and are not powerless to rescue them and to save them.

- THE THRONE (2,3)

 - It is a picture God's glory, rule, and sovereignty. He is the Almighty. He is in control. He is worthy of the adoration of all that is on earth and in heaven.



THE THRONE (2,3)


- The message is that the God of heaven, if He could only be seen with human eyes, seated as He is upon His heavenly throne, far surpasses the majesty and mystery of the Roman Caesar's court.
- Rome cannot compare with heaven. Caesar cannot compare with God Almighty.

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- AROUND THE THRONE (4-5)
 - ▶ 24 thrones: Representative of God's reigning covenant people, both of fleshly and spiritual Israel [12 tribes / 12 apostles] (21:12, 14).
 - Clothed in white robes: Signifying their sins had been cleansed and made pure by the blood of Christ.
 - They had crowns of gold on their heads: symbolizes their victory over God's enemies.


Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- AROUND THE THRONE (4-5)
 - ▶ "From the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices:" God's omnipotent presence and power similar to the sounds and sights that caused the children of Israel to tremble (Exod. 19:16; cf. Hebrews 12:18-29).
 - "7 lamps of fire / the 7 Spirits of God:" The work of the Holy Spirit is that of revealing the truth (Jn 16:13), lamps of fire burning offer a graphic portrayal of this mission.



BEFORE THE THRONE (6-10)


- of glass clear as crystal represents God in his transcendence, separated from his people. Later John relates that there is "no more sea" (21:1).
- "four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back:" (lion, young bull, man, eagle) also appear, with six wings each, reminiscent of the vision in Isaiah 6:2. They could maintain constant vigil over all God's creation.

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)




- THE 4 LIVING CREATURES (7-8)
 - The symbolism of the 4 living creatures around God's throne is also found in Eze. 1:5,10,18, where living creatures are identified as "cherubims" (Eze. 10:20).
 - A very high order of angels who execute God's will and are assigned the work of guarding holy things. (Gen. 3:24; Exod. 25:18-22).

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- THE 4 LIVING CREATURES (7-8)
 - The lion represents strength.
 - The **calf** ("ox"), among domesticated animals, is a beast of patient service and endurance.
 - Man signifies intelligence, reason, and wisdom.
 - An eagle, the prince of the skies, perhaps represents penetrating vision and swiftness.
- The highest of the heavenly host serve the Father.

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- WORSHIP IN HEAVEN (8-11)
 - **"Holy, holy, holy"** God is Holy and worthy of all praise (Isa. 6:3)
 - Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity" (Hab. 1:11, 13).
 - but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, ... (1 Pet. 1:15-16).
 - The Lord God Almighty Sovereign OVER ALL THINGS!
 - ETERNAL beyond time and space.

WORSHIP IN HEAVEN (8-11)

- These who are of the highest order of heavenly beings are praising the Father because they know his true nature.
- The representatives of God's covenant people join with the cherubims who surround the throne to worship and praise God.
- They were NOT worthy of their glorified state They praised God for His GLORY, mercy and LOVE, which has enabled man to overcome Satan!


Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

- John gets to enter a visual door and see into heaven 4:1-2
- He sees the awesome throne of God 4:2-3
- He sees 24 elders totally awed by God 4:4
- Honor and glory belong wholly to God 4:5-6

Cycle One: The Seal Sequence (4:1-8:1)



- Four Living Creatures are fixed on worshipping and serving God 4:6-8
- Glory and honor to God is all important and no one can question His deserving status 4:9-11

- I Must Truly Believe:
 - God Deserves GLORY
 - God Deserves HONOR
 - God Deserves THANKS
 - God is WORTHY To Receive These Things From ME
 - My perception of God's greatness, majesty, sovereignty, righteousness and love will determine how I live & serve Him.

Ezekiel 1:26–28 (NKJV)
