Restoring straying saints is a responsibility given to the spiritual cf. Ga 6:1-2; 1 Th 5:14; Jude 1:20-23 A duty too often neglected - Eze 34:4

- Jesus says such a person is in danger of more serious punishment (Lk 12:47-48)
- Peter speaks of those who "know" the truth and turn from it "the latter end is worse for them than the beginning" (2 Pe 2:20-22)





WHY? - THE DANGER IS REAL Hebrews 10:26–31 (NKJV) ²⁶ For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, ²⁷ but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. ²⁸ Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses.






WHY? - THE DANGER IS REAL Hobrows 10.26, 21 (NK IV)

²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? ³⁰ For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. 





James 5:19–20 (NKJV)


