

The **imagery** and **symbols** in Revelation are necessary in comprehending the **BIG PICTURE** - but if we focus too much on the imagery and symbols we can easily MISS the BIG PICTURE.

The BIG PICTURE in chapters 8:2-11:19 is clearly **GOD WILL BRING CALAMITY** upon those who persecute His people.

Revelation 8:4 (NKJV) ⁴ And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand.

- A series of three "7's" 7 seals (6:1-8:5); 7 trumpets (8:6-9:21); and 7 bowls of wrath (15:1-16:21).
- John describes them one after the other by revealing from different viewpoints the judging and restraining action of God.

Those who prayed for help in their distress CAN know that God HEARS - it would be their prayers that initiate divine judgment.



 The natural calamities symbolized by the first 4 trumpets have weakened the Empire (8:1-13)

The 5th and 6th trumpets introduce the last two factors that contributed to the demise of the Roman Empire. (9:1-21)

THE 5TH & 6TH TRUMPETS (9:1-21)

- Before the 7th trumpet we see one of John's interlude visions, much like we saw in ch. 7 (10:1-11:14)
- Before proceeding with the 7th trumpet, John speaks to the mission of believers to a lost and dying world.

 7TH TRUMPET SOUNDS (11:15)
 The previous 6 trumpets sounded an alarm calling for men to repent in the face of imminent judgment.

- When the seventh trumpet is sounded, great voices are heard in heaven praising God.
- The 7th trumpet announces the climax of the book: Christ Reigns! (Rev. 12:10; Dan. 2:44; 7:14, 27)

Revelation 11:16–17 (NKJV)

16 And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God, saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

7TH TRUMPET SOUNDS (11:15)
 The twenty-four elders prostrate themselves and with bowed heads worship God and give Him thanks.

- Their obeisance (proskunēsis) is described almost verbatim as it is pictured in 4:10.(1:8; 4:8-10).
- God has accomplished the ultimate victory over His enemies.

Revelation 11:16–17 (NKJV)

¹⁶ And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God. saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

- The reign of God is in one sense eternal (cf. Psa. 93:1-4).
- God has ruled throughout human history by commanding men and angels to obey His laws and worship Him, but He has reigned over a rebellious world.
- The day would come when God would "TAKE" what is rightfully His! (Phili. 2:8-10)

Revelation 11:18 (NKJV)

¹⁸ The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, And the time of the dead, that they should be judged. And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great, And should destroy those who destroy the earth."

- The conflict will be described in greater detail in future visions, but the church is assured what will be the final outcome. (2 Thes. 1:7-10)
 - The saints shall be rewarded,
 whereas those who have tried to
 extinguish the kingdom of God
 from the earth shall themselves be
 crushed and destroyed.

Revelation IIII9 (NKJV) ¹⁹ Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an

- In 4:1 the door of heaven was opened, and here the temple is opened in heaven, the two terms are meant to be equivalent.
- Here he sees in his vision the heavenly archetype of which the original physical ark was but a pathetic copy (Exod. 25:40; cf. Heb. 8:5; 9:7-10,).

Revelation 11:19 (NKJV) Then the temple of God

was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

- Under the Mosaic dispensation, the ark of the covenant was kept in the Holy of Holies where the high priest would enter only one time annually to appear before God (Exod. 25:22).
- Christians have boldness to enter into the Holy of Holies through the blood of Christ (Heb. 9:12,19-28).

Revelation II:19 (NKJV) 19 Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

- Just as the Ark of the Covenant was a symbol to old Israel of God's abiding presence, God reveals these things to John to assure and strengthen His people in the face of what is to come.
- God intends to console, comfort, reassure and embolden the frightened Christians of Asia Minor in the face of the ominous coming judgments that are directed against the wicked in the chapters that are to follow.

This world has repeatedly brought suffering to the people of God, but the day will come when God will avenge His saints, and glorify His people.
