The plural, "times", appears 146 times in 142 verses of the 66 books of the Bible in the King James Bible

































- The time of the coming of the Lord is always questioned (Matthew 24:36).

- The time in which the world will be destroyed (II Peter 3:10).











































ATIME TO...


ATIME TO ...


- All Christians (individually) have the obligation "to visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction" (Jas. 1:27)

ATIME TO...


- In Lk. 9:23 Jesus said: "If any man come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow me."

- Don't be afraid to pray in public. To offer thanks at a a restaurant.





