### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDAINCE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES



- Our fears can be conquered through genuine Faith, hope and love (Psalm 56:3–4; Isaiah 26:3–4; Philippians 4:6–7; I Peter 1:3-5; 5:6–7; I John 4:18–19; Heb. 11:1-12:3)
- The book of James provides much valuable & practical instruction on how to respond to adversity ...

## HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (III) ON THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### WITH AN INFORMED PERSPECTIVE (1:2-12)



- COUNT 1:2 "count it all joy when you fall into various trials," to consider, deem, account, think (Thayer)
- **KNOW** 1:3 "knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience." to know, understand, perceive (Thayer) -
- LET 1:4 "But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete,"
   to hold one's self to a thing, (Thayer)
- ASK FOR WISDOM 1:5-8 "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, ... 6But let him ask in faith, ..."

## HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDAINCE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### WITH AN INFORMED PERSPECTIVE (1:2-20)



- "because as a flower of the field he will pass away." Earthly wealth & pursuits perish.
- VICTORY 1:12 "he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him." (Rom. 8:17,18,28; 1 Pet. 1:3-9)
  - God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. . . . <sup>17</sup> Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, . . . <sup>19</sup> be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;''

### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDATICE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### BY BEING DOERS OF THE WORD (1:21-3:12)



- MEEKLY RECEIVE THE WORD -
  - 1:21- "receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."
- **GUARD AGAINST DECEPTION -**
  - 1:22 "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." (Matt. 7:21–28; Luke 6:46–49; Rom. 2:13)
- MUST CONTINUE TO ENSURE

**BLESSING** - 1:25 "he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, ... a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does." (2 Pet. 1:5-10)

### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (III) THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### BY BEING DOERS OF THE WORD (1:21-3:12)



PRACTICE PURE & UNDEFILED
RELIGION - 1:26,27- "27 Pure and
undefiled religion before God and the Father
is this: to visit orphans and widows in their
trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from

the world." (Matt. 25:34–36)

PARTIALITY - 2:1-13 "do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality. . . . 8 . . . "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," . . . 13 . . . Mercy triumphs over judgment." (Jno. 7:24; Ro. 14:3, 4, 10–13)

### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (III) THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### BY BEING DOERS OF THE WORD (1:21-3:12)



#### WITH A FAITH THAT WORKS -

2:14-26 "14if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? ... <sup>17</sup> Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. ... <sup>22</sup> ... by works faith was made perfect? ... <sup>24</sup> You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only."

#### BY BRIDLING OUR TONGUE -

3:1-12 "2 … If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body. … 6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. … defiles the whole body,"

## HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDITICE FROM THE BOOK OF JIMES

#### WITH WISDOM FROM ABOVE (3:13-18)



- GOOD CONDUCT 3:13 "13 ... Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom."
- 3:14-16 "15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. <sup>16</sup> For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there."
- BEAR FRUIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS
   3:17,18 "17 ... pure, then peaceable, gentle,

willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy."

### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDANCE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### DRAW NEARTO GOD (4:1-12)



- FORSAKE THE WORLD 4:1-5 "4 .... Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God."
- HUMBLY SUBMIT TO GOD 4:6,7,10 "6" God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble. <sup>7</sup> Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you."
- DO RIGHT, BE LOYAL TO GOD 4:8 "8 ... Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded."
- MOURN OVER SIN 4:9 "9 your laughter be turned to mourning ..."

## HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDAINCE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### TAKE ADVANTAGE OF TODAY (4:13-17)



- "... <sup>14</sup> whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow."
- LIFE IS REALLY SHORT 4:14 "14" For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away."
- "15 ... you *ought* to say, "If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that."
- O.A.=R 4:17" ... to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin."

## HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (III) ON THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### BE PATIENT / DON'T COMPLAIN (5:1-12)



- DO NOT ENVY THE WEALTHY -
  - 5:1-6 "... Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you! <sup>2</sup> Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten. ..."
- BE PATIENT & BE FIRMLY FIXED 5:7,8 "8 ... be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand."
- REMEMBER JOB 5:9-11 "11 ... You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end *intended by* the Lord—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful."

### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (UIDANCE FROM THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### EFFECTIVE, FERVENT PRAYER (5:13-20)



- SEEK GOD'S SUPPORT 5:13 "13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray."
- SEEK SUPPORT FROM ELDERS 5:14 "14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ..."
- THE PRAYER OF FAITH WILL SUSTAIN THE WEAK 5:15 " 15 ....

And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up." (Ps. 50:14, 15; Mat. 21:21, 22; 1 Th. 5:17; Hebrews 5:7)


### HOW A BELIEVER SHOULD RESPOND TO ADVERSITY (III) THE BOOK OF JAMES

#### EFFECTIVE, FERVENT PRAYER (5:13-20)



- FORGIVENESS 5:15,16" 15 ... if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. 16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed ..."
- GOD HEARS THE RIGHTEOUS 5:16" 16 ... The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." (John 9:310
- SEEK TO RESTORE THE STRAYING 5:19,20 "19 ... he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death" (Matt. 18:15; Gal. 6:1)

### 1 Peter 4:12–19 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; 13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. 14 If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. 15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's

#### 1 Peter 4:12-19 (NKJV)

16 Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter. <sup>17</sup> For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" 19 Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.
