- 1:3 charge some that they teach no other doctrine
- 1:18 wage the good warfare 6:12
- 2:1-8 teach men to pray
- 3:1-7 appoint bishops (elders—Titus
  1:5-9)
- 3:8-13 appoint deacons

- 4:1-11 be nourished in the words of faith and good doctrine; instruct the brethren
- Reject profane and simple fables
   6:3-5,20 avoid the divisive teachers
- 4:7 Exercise yourself to godliness
   Hebrews 5:14
- 4:12 be an example
- 4:13 read, encourage, teach

- 4:15-16 meditate, grow, save others
- 5:1-2 treat Christians as family
- 5:3-16 teach distinction between individual and church responsibilities
- 5:17-18 honor elders
- 5:19-25 be slow to judge

   (God has not given us a spirit of fear)
- 1:13 hold fast the pattern of sound words
- 2:1-13 endure hardship (God has given us a spirit of power)
- 2:1 be strong in the grace in Christ

- 2:2 Train faithful men to teach others
- 2:10 endure all things to save others
- 2:14-26 (God has given us a spirit of love)
- 2:14 remind Christians of reward after suffering and to avoid harmful arguments
- 2:15 Be diligent in work; correctly handle the word of truth

- 2:19 depart from iniquity
- 2:22 flee youthful lusts
- 2:24-26 teach to win the soul instead of the argument
- 3:1-4:8 (God has given us a spirit of a sound mind)
