## ACCEPTABLE WORSHIP IS NOT defined merely by what is pleasing & acceptable to us? (Phil 3:18,19; Rom 1:25)







### Acts 17:22-23 (NKJV)



## 10 GREEK WORDS TRANSLATED "WORSHIP"



- Thayer Definition: proskuneo (προσκυνέω, 4352)
  - (1)to kiss the hand to (towards) one, in token of reverence
  - (2) among the Orientals, especially the Persians, to fall upon the knees and touch the ground with the forehead as an expression of profound reverence
  - (3) in the NT by kneeling or prostration to do homage (to one) or make obeisance, whether in order to express respect or to make supplication 3a) used of homage shown to men and beings of superior rank.

## 10 GREEK WORDS TRANSLATED "WORSHIP"



- **Vines Definition:** proskuneo (προσκυνέω, 4352)
  - (1)"to make obeisance, do reverence to" (from pros, "towards," and kuneo, "to kiss"), is the most frequent word rendered "to worship." It is used of an act of homage or reverence. (a) to God, e.g., Matt. 4:10; John 4:21-24; 1 Cor. 14:25; Rev. 4:10; 5:14; 7:11; 11:16; 19:10 (2nd part) and 22:9; (b) to Christ, e.g., Matt. 2:2, 8, 11; 8:2; 9:18; 14:33; 15:25; 20:20; 28:9, 17; John 9:38; Heb. 1:6, in a quotation from the Sept. of Deut. 32:43, referring to Christ's second advent;

#### **GENERAL PRINCIPLES GOVERNING WORSHIP**

John 4:23-24 (NKJV) <sup>23</sup> But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. <sup>24</sup> God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worsh in spirit and truth.

- Must be directed to God (Jn 4:23; Rev. 14:7; Ep 5:19)
- Must be in spirit & truth (Jn 4:24)
- Must be authorized (Col. 3:17; Mat. 15:7-9)
- Must be done decently and in order (1 Cor. 14:40)
- Involves sacrifice (Heb 13:14-16)

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God has always ONLY accepted worship from those who offered it from their heart (in spirit) and in accordance with His Law (& truth).

Physical ordinances of the OT were until "the time of reformation" (He 9:9-10), i.e., the NT.

NT worship is more in keeping with the nature of God & relates more to the spiritual side of man.

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We should expect the worship in this age, to which the shadows in the OT pointed, to be governed by the spiritual realities which now exist, and therefore be different from that of the shadow.

### GENERAL PRINCIPLES GOVERNING WORSHIP

OT - carnal (fleshly) ordinances. Heb	NT worship geared more to spiritual side of man
A physical structure (tabernacle / Temple)	Temple spiritual, Christians - 1 Co 3:16; Ep 2:19-22
Special priesthood, clothing for priests	All Christians priests, spiritual sacrifices - 1 Peter 2:5,9
Lamps, burning incense	Prayers sweet incense - Re 5:8
Instruments of music	Melody made in heart - Ep 5:19
Feast days	Lord's Supper - 1Co 10:16-17
Animal & meal sacrifices	Spiritual sacrifices - He 13:15; Ro 12:1-2


Scriptural worship – the focus is on the Creator - NOT the creature -(John 4:24; Romans 1:25)

The Lord's supper

  - SINGING psalms, hymns & spiritual songs (Eph 5:19; Col. 3:16)
  - Preaching / teaching (Acts 20:7; 1 Cor 14; Eph 4:12-16)


### N.T. PATTERN FOR COPORATE WORSHIP

## ORSHIP MIITR?



- True worship is revealed worship (Rom. 10:17; Jn 4:22)
- Sincerity & zeal is NOT enough! (Acts 23:1; 26:9; Rom. 10:1-3)
- Untaught worship prevents true worship (Rom. 10:1-3; Acts 17:21-30)

We do not have the right to change or take lightly God's prescribed pattern for worship - Mat 15:1-9; 2 Jn 1:9,10




Obeying God's revealed will is the ONLY way we can show reverence for Him -Eccl 12:13,14; Rom 101-3
