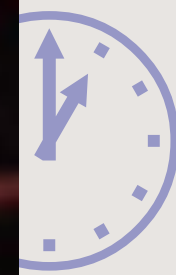

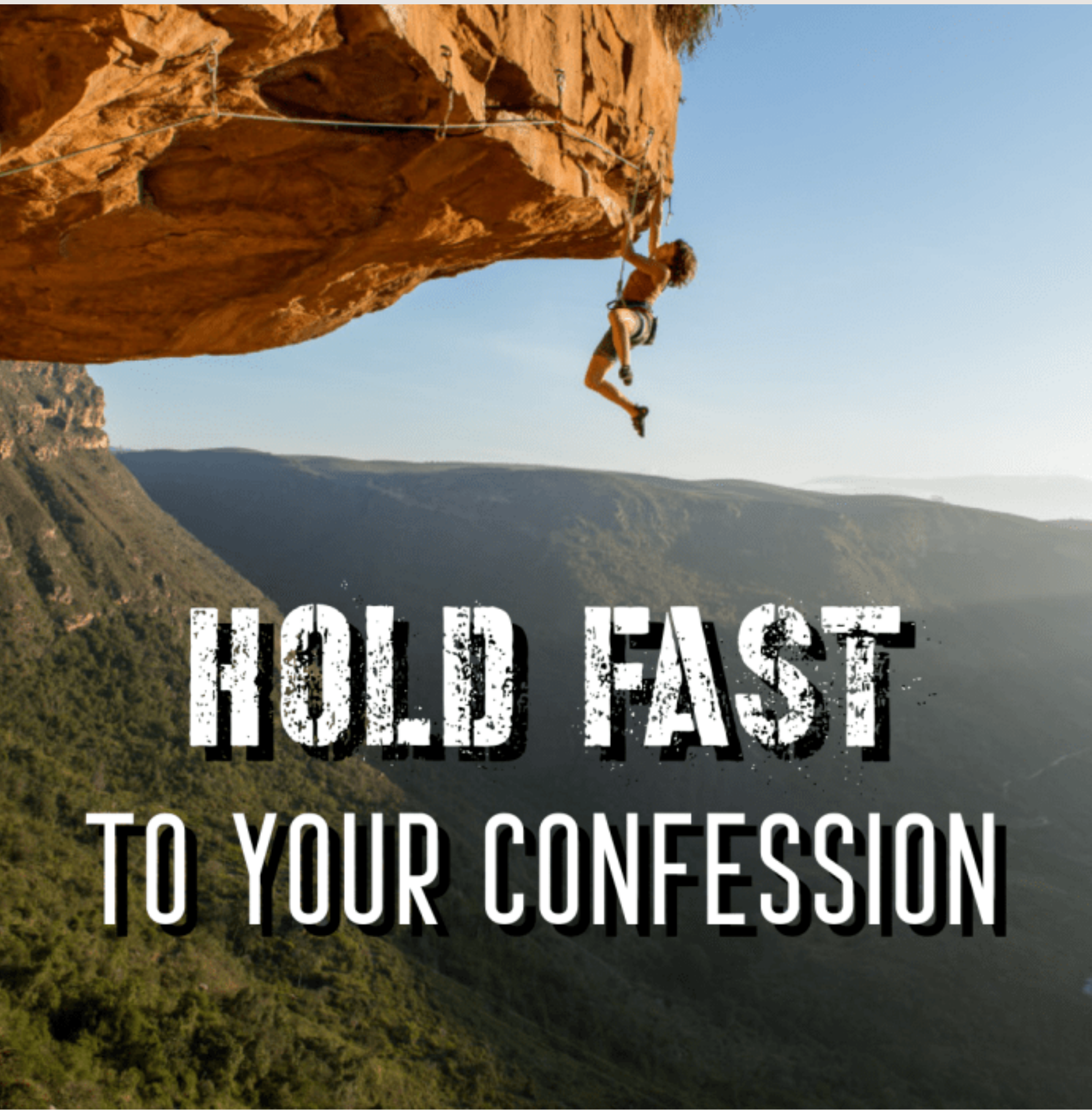

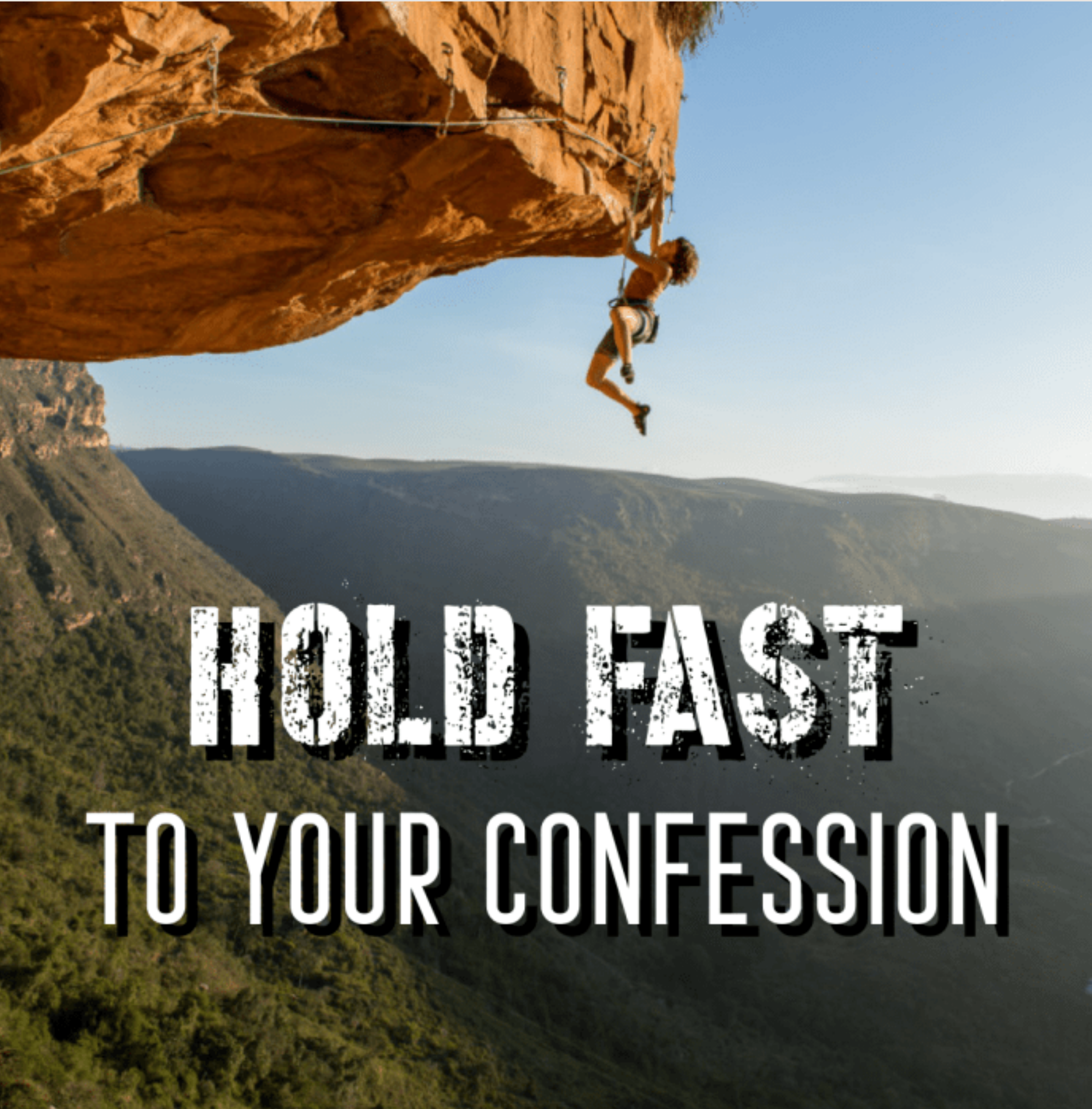

- 🕒 **MUST** live out that hope by remaining faithful to Him



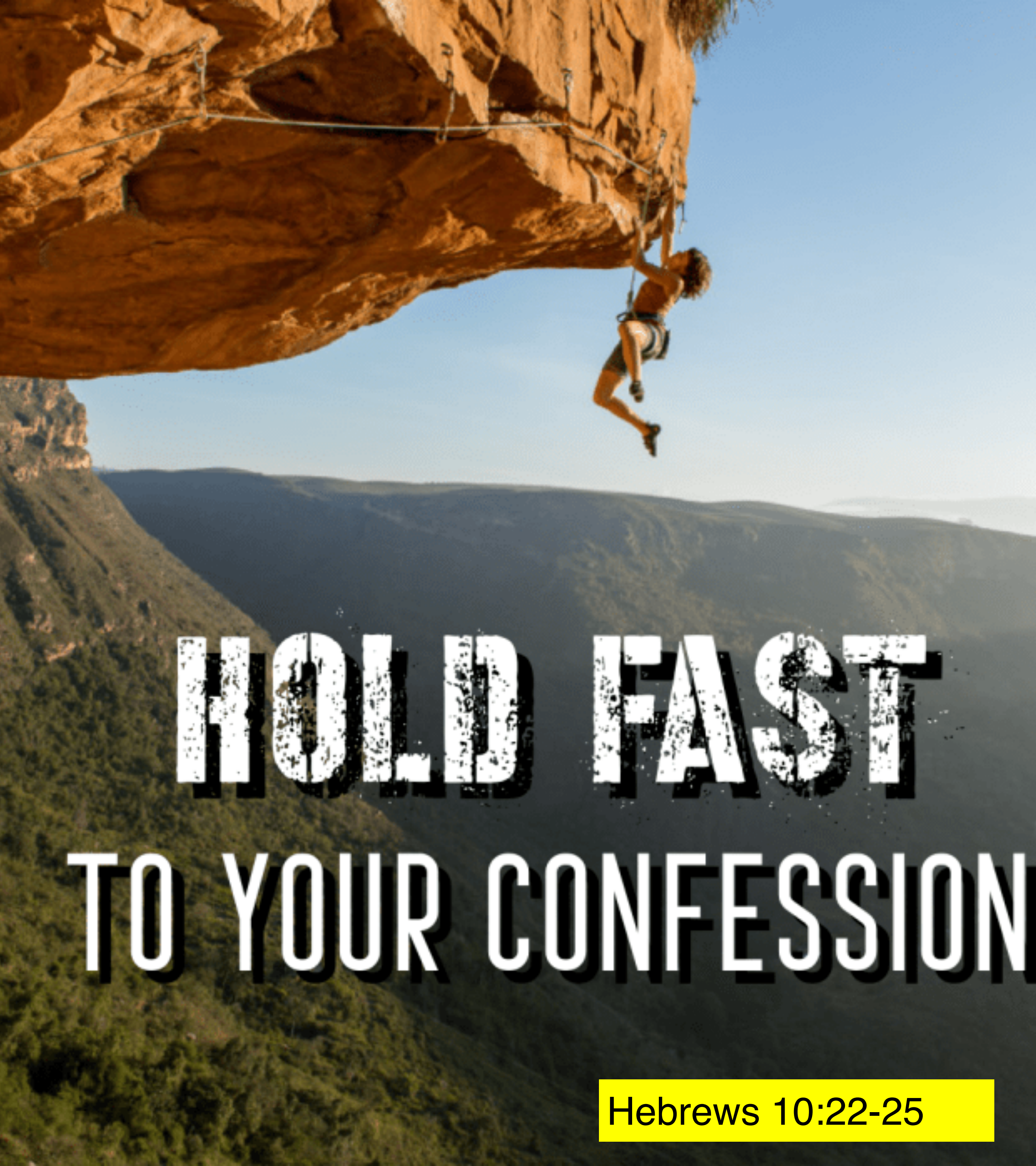

Holding On- Reminders

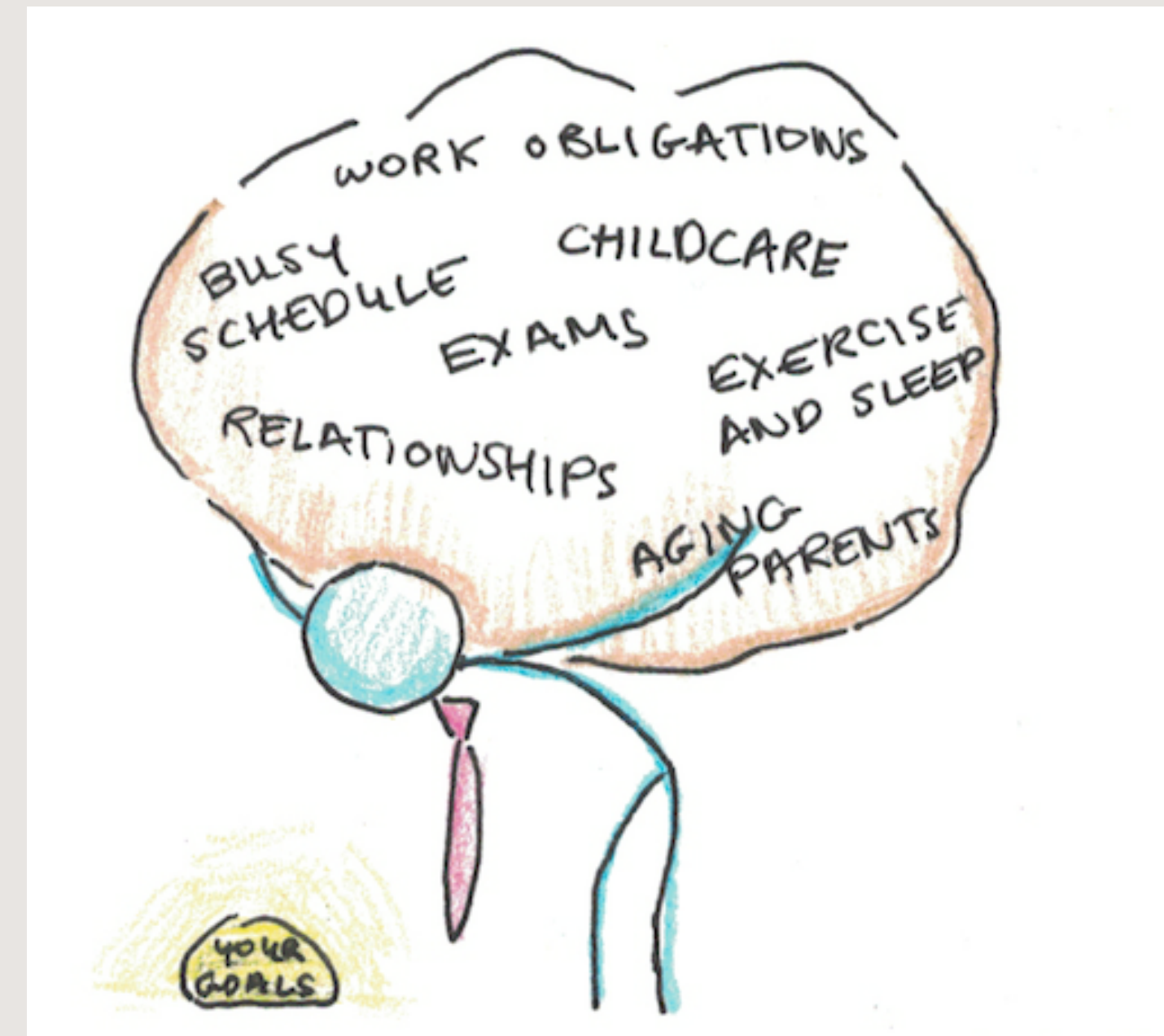


Luke 12:13-21

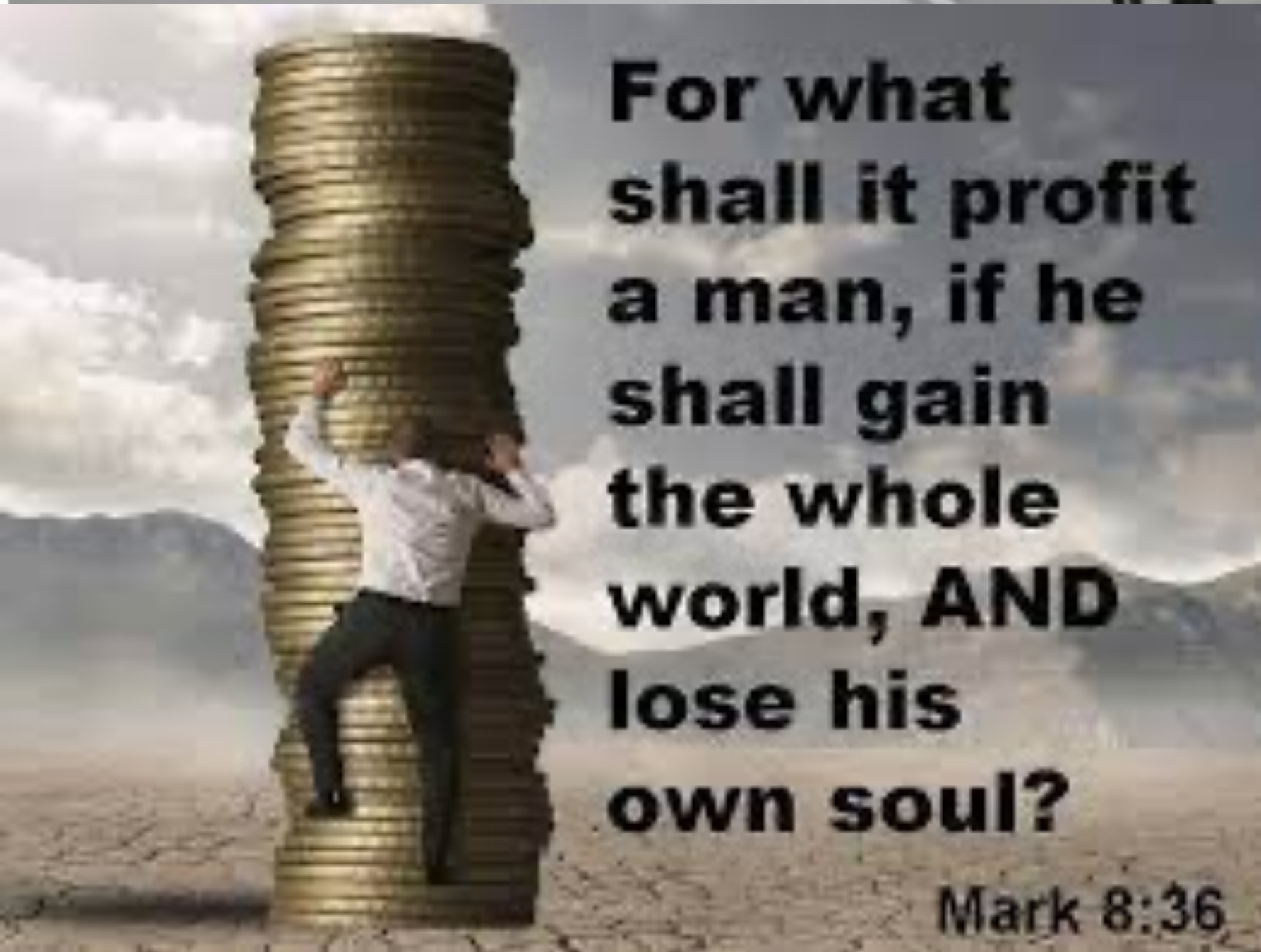


