THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

Purpose of John

- John wrote, "And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book, but these are written that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." 20:31
- Psalm 2 connects the Christ (the Anointed One)
 with the title, "The Son of God"
- v.2 men oppose the LORD and His Anointed
- v.6 God still made Him king on Zion
- v.7 God declares that He is His Son

The Case for Jesus as Christ

- John presents his case for Jesus as the Christ, the Son of God:
 - Opening Statement 1:1-18
 - Claims ("I am" statements)
 - Evidence (Signs)
 - Witnesses (provided by God)
 - Character Witnesses (reactions to words and deeds of Jesus)

The Word was with God and was God v.1 (unbound by space and time limitations)

The Word made EVERYTHING v.3

He is the life-giving light v.4-5, 9-13

He became flesh and dwelt among us v.14 (subjected Himself to limitations of space and time)

Born after John, comes after John, but existed before John v.15 (see also v.6-8,29-36)

Jesus Christ is the Word with God in Heaven and brought grace and truth with Him from Heaven v.17

Jesus Christ, the Word, has fully revealed the Father v.18 (see 14:6-8)

He became flesh and dwelt among us v.14 (subjected Himself to limitations of space and time)

Time is important in John

"In the beginning..." begins the book

"My hour," "His hour" repeated often

Details of Jesus' first week in 1:19-2:12

Details of His final week in 21:1-19:42

Three year ministry based on Jesus' Passover trips 2:13-25; 6:4; 13:1

He became flesh and dwelt among us v.14 (subjected Himself to limitations of space and time) Location is important in John

A. In the beginning was the Word...with God v.1a

B. The Word was God v.1b

A' He was in the beginning with God v.2

Jesus brought grace and truth when He came from Heaven v.17

He would return to the Father in Heaven 14:1-12; 17:5

He became flesh and dwelt among us v.14 (subjected Himself to limitations of space and time) Location is important in John

Jesus often stated that He came from Heaven (sent by the Father—3:11-21; 5:36-37; 6:29-58; 7:15-18,26-29,33-34; 8:14-29,42; 11:42; 12:44-50)

John also told his disciples that Jesus came from Heaven 3:25-36

Christ's place of origin was a stumblingblock for many Jews 1:45-46; 7:27,41-52; 8:48-59; 9:16,29-34

- "I am the bread of life" 6:35
- "I am the light of the world" 8:12
- "I am the door of the sheep" 10:7
- "I am the good shepherd" 10:11
- "I am the resurrection and the life" 11:25
