






The vanity of their worship in Bethel and Gilgal – (4:4,5)


Acts 10:42 (NKJV) 42 And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead.









Hebrews 4:13 (NKJV) 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.








Hebrews 9:27 (NKJV) 27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,











Romans 2:16 (NKJV) ¹⁶ in the day when secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.




