WE ARE "FORCE FED" **UNGODLINESS! WEARE "CANCELED" IF WE STAND UP FOR TRUTH & SPEAK OUT** WE ARE LABELED AS **JUDGMENTAL &** HATEFUL IF WE **REFUSE TO BOW!**

TO OPPOSE THAT WHICH IS **CONTRARY TO GOD'S WILL &** WAY, AS REVEALED IN THE BIBLE, IS **AN ACTION OF** TRUE LOVE -NOT HATE!

IT IS TRUE LOVE -NOT HATE:

To inform people of what God has said about sin (1 Cor. 6:9-11; Gal. 5:19-21; Rom. 1:18-32)

To warn people of God's judgment (2 Pet. 3:9-14; Acts 17:30,31; Rom. 2:5-11; 2 Cor. 5:10,11; 2 Thes. 1:7-9)

To emphasize the eternal rather than the temporal (Jn 6:27; Mt. 6:19; 1 Jn 2:15-17; 2 Pe. 3:9-14)

Isaiah 5:20–21 (NKJV) ²⁰ Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; Who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; Who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! ²¹ Woe to *those who are* wise in their own eyes, And prudent in their own sight!

Isaiah 55:7–9 (NKJV) ⁷ Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon. ⁸ "For My thoughts *are* not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. ⁹ "For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

WE CANNOT STAND WITH GOD AND WITH **EVIL AT THE SAME TIME** Proverbs 3:5–7 (NKJV) ⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. 7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord and depart from evil.

WE CANNOT STAND WITH GOD AND WITH EVIL AT THE SAME TIME

Matthew 6:24 (NKJV)

²⁴ "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

STANDING WITH GOD REQUIRES STANDING AGAINST ALL THAT IS SINFUL

Psalm 97:10 (NKJV) ¹⁰ You who love the Lord, hate evil! He preserves the souls of His saints; He delivers them out of the hand of the wicked.

STANDING WITH GOD REQUIRES STANDING AGAINST ALL THAT IS SINFUL

Amos 5:14–15 (NKJV)

¹⁴ Seek good and not evil, That you may live; So the Lord God of hosts will be with you, As you have spoken. ¹⁵ Hate evil, love good; Establish justice in the gate. It may be that the Lord God of hosts Will be gracious to the remnant of Joseph.

STANDING WITH GOD REQUIRES STANDING AGAINST ALL THAT IS SINFUL

Psalm 34:11–14 (NKJV)

¹¹ Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord. ¹²
¹² Who *is* the man *who* desires life, And loves *many* days, that he may see good?
¹³ Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit. ¹⁴
¹⁴ Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it. *[cf. 1 Pet. 3:10–12]*

STANDING WITH GOD REQUIRES STANDING AGAINST ALL THAT IS SINFUL

Romans 12:9 (NKJV) ⁹ Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.

STANDING WITH GOD REQUIRES STANDING AGAINST ALL THAT IS SINFUL

Ephesians 5:8–13 (NKJV)

⁸ For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), ¹⁰ finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. ¹¹ And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose *them*.

Daniel 3:16–18 (NKJV) ¹⁶ Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. ¹⁷ If that *is the* case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. ¹⁸ But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up."

Acts 4:18-20 (NKJV) ¹⁸ So they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. 19 But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. ²⁰ For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard."

WE MUST BOW BEFORE GOD & STAND W/ HIM BEFORE MEN

Acts 5:28–29 (NKJV) ²⁸ saying, "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this Man's blood on us!" ²⁹ But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men.

WE MUST BOW BEFORE GOD & STAND W/ HIM BEFORE MEN

1 Peter 4:2–5 (NKJV) ² that he no longer should live the rest of *his* time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. ³ For we have spent enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles—when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries.

WE MUST BOW BEFORE GOD & STAND W/ HIM BEFORE MEN

1 Peter 4:2–5 (NKJV) ⁴ In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you. ⁵ They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

All Immorality (1 Cor. 6:9-11; Gal. 5:19-21; Rom. 1:18-32; Eph. 5:3-18)

1 Corinthians 6:9–10 (NKJV)
⁹ Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

2 Timothy 4:2–5 (NKJV)
⁴ and they will turn *their* ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. ⁵ But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

What the Bible teaches about right & wrong / moral & immoral / obedience and sin (1 Cor. 6:9-11; 1 Jn 3:4)

LET US ALWAYS STAND IN DEFENSE OF THE TRUTH!

The errors of denominationalism & the singularity & unity of the church belonging to Jesus (Jn. 17:20,21; 1 Cor. 1:10-13; Eph. 4:1-6)

What constitutes true worship (Jn 4:23,24; Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:17-34; 14:26; Col. 3:16,17)

The nature, organization and work of the church as taught in the Bible (Eph. 5:22-25; Phil. 1:1; 1 Tim. 3:1-13)

2nd coming (Jn. 5:28,29; 2 Pet. 3:10-14)

BOW TO JESUS! If you believe that Jesus is the Christ act upon that faith today by confessing Him as the Son of God - Repent of your sins - and be baptized for the remission of your sins TODAY!

BOW TO JESUS! If you are a **Christian but guilty** of compromising your your faith by bowing to the world - repent, confess & pray TODAY!
