- Greeting: Grace & peace 1:7b
- Thanksgiving: 1:8-12
- Body: 1:13-15:33
- Closing Remarks: 16:1-24
- Final Prayer: 16:25-27

A Simplified Approach to Romans

- 2 Peter 3:14-18 in Paul's writings, some things are hard to understand v.16
- Many have twisted passages in Romans to their own destruction (Judaism, Calvinism)
- Words in chapters 5,7,9,11 misunderstood misunderstandings form basis of error
- Then the plain teachings in chapters 6,8,10
 (as well as the rest of the scriptures) are
 twisted to fit the error

- I. Righteousness of God is revealed in the Gospel of Christ 1:18-11:36
 - A. 1:13-17 introduction of the theme:
 - 1. 1:16 states the theme:

The gospel of Christ is the power of God unto salvation, for everyone who believes, to the Jew first and to the Greek

- 2. 1:17 outlines the body:
- a. In the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed (from faith to faith) 1:18-11:36
- b. The just shall live by faith 12:1-15:33

- B. 1:18-5:21 "Need—Solution" Argument:
- 1. The Need: All have sinned 1:18-3:20
- a. Gentiles 1:18-32
- b. Jews 2:1-29
- c. all 3:1-20 (1+2=3)
- 2. The Solution: God's righteousness thru faith of Christ Jesus to all those believing 3:21-5:21

- 2. The Solution: God's righteousness thru faith of Christ Jesus to all those believing 3:21-5:21
- a. the provision of the propitiation 3:21-26
- b. No law can save sinners 3:27-31
- c. Justification thru faith apart from the law exemplified 4:1-25 (Abraham, David)
- d. Hope based on love of God 5:1-11
- e. Provision just as universal as need 5:12-21 (example of Adam's sin: sign argument, not cause argument)

- C. 6:1-11:34 Judaist objections to the gospel are anticipated and answered in advance:
 - 1. "Doctrine of grace encourages sin" 6:1-23
 - a. Parallel rhetorical questions 1,15
 - b. Parallel "Certainly not!" responses 2,15
 - c. Parallel "Do you not know..." explanations why not 3-14,16-23
 - d. Parallel descriptions of when & how our relationship with sin ended 3-4,17-18

- C. 6:1-11:34 Judaist objections to the gospel are anticipated and answered in advance:
 - 2. "So why did God give the law?" 7:1-8:39
 - a. The wretched condition 7:1-25
 - 1) dead to the law 1-6
 - 2) dead in the law 7-25
 - b. The blessed condition 8:1-39
 - 1) sons of God led by the Spirit 1-17
 - 2) heirs of God hope in God's love 18-39

- C. 6:1-11:36 Judaist objections to the gospel are anticipated and answered in advance:
 - 3. "We are God's chosen people!" 9:1-11:36
 - a. Not all of Israel are Israel 9:1-13
 - b. God chose Israel as the nation to bring salvation (YESHUA—"JESUS") to all nations (including Israel) in the same way 9:14-33
 - c. The unbelieving Jews rejected righteousness of God, established their own righteousness 10:1-21
 - 1) righteousness by the law (does) 1-5,18-21
 - 2) righteousness by faith (the word in the heart and mouth) 6-17
 - d. God has not rejected the Jews 11:1-36

- C. 6:1-11:36 Judaist objections to the gospel are anticipated and answered in advance:
 - 3. "We are God's chosen people!" 9:1-11:36
 - a. God has not rejected the Jews 11:1-36
 - 1) the faithful remnant are chosen 1-6
 - 2) majority didn't find grace 7-10
 - 3) Gentiles found grace by faith in hope of stirring Jews to look to Christ for grace 11-27
 - 4) in this way (HOUTOS) all Israel will be saved 25-27
 - 5) God wise not to violate free will 28-36

- II. The Just Shall Live by Faith 12:1-15:33
 - A. 12:1-13:14 a living sacrifice
 - 1. Renew the mind and apply God's will 12:1-2
 - 2. Love one another 12:3-16
 - a. Use gifts to build up one another 3-8
 - b. godly attitudes --> godly actions 9-16
 - 3. Live godly in the world 12:17-13:14
 - a. Love enemies 12:17-21
 - b. Submit to government 13:1-7
 - c. Love your neighbor 13:8-14

- II. The Just Shall Live by Faith 12:1-15:33
 - B. 14:1-15:33 Dealing with Differences in Gentile/Jew relationships
 - 1. Don't judge another's conscience 14:1-12
 - 2. Don't wound another's conscience 14:13-15:6
 - 3. Accept Gentiles as brothers 15:7-33
 - a. Ministry for the Gentiles 15:7-21
 - b. Ministry by the Gentiles 15:22-33
- (The conclusion in Romans 16 also reinforces the Jew/Gentile bond--express love for each other)

Where to Find the Righteousness of God

- IN CHRIST Rom. 3:21-26
- Believe in Jesus CHRIST 10:9-10
- Confess Jesus as LORD 10:9
- Repent (commit to submitting to His authority) 2:4
- Be baptized into Christ Jesus 6:3-7
- Walk in newness of life 6:4
