- of Your strength Isaiah 11:4 The rod of His mouth (Christ) see v.1,5,10; power Rm 1:16
- out of Zion Isa. 2:1-4; Lk 24:44-47

Rule in the midst of Your enemies Luke
 19:11-27 Jesus did not destroy His enemies and then rule; He's ruling until they are destroyed 1 Cor. 15:20-28

- in the beauties of holiness Hb 7:26 Christ is holy; all that is His is holy 1 Cor. 3:9-17
- We are to be clothed in holiness Rev. 3:4-5;
 Gal. 3:27; 1 Peter 1:13-16
- from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. Micah 5:7 remnant of Jacob is dew from the LORD
- We are eager to serve in the LORD's army and fight for Christ in spiritual battle Eph 6:10-20; Isa. 59:15b-17; Titus 2:14

- Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; in the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth.
