

THE EVERLISTING Revelation 14:6–7 (NKJV)

⁶ Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—⁷ saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."



Romans 1:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."



- THE GOSPEL (GOOD NEWS)
 OF CHRIST includes:
 - FACTS which MUST BE BELIEVED (Mark 1:15; John 8:24; 1 Cor. 15:1-4; Rom. 10:4-17)
 - TEACHING which MUST BE FOLLOWED (Mat. 28:19,20; Luke 6:46; 9:23-26; Rom. 1:5; 10:16; 16:25,26; 2 Thes. 1:7-9; 1 Pet. 4:27; 2 John 9)
 - PROMISES to be received (Col. 1:23; Ro. 5:5; Ga. 5:5; Ep. 1:18; 1 Th. 5:8; 2 Th. 2:16; Tit. 3:7; He. 6:19; 1 Pe. 1:3; 1 Jno. 3:1–3)



Deuteronomy 18:18-19 (NKJV)

¹⁸ I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. ¹⁹ And it shall be *that* whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require *it* of him.



John 1:45 (NKJV)

⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."



John 6:14 (NKJV)

14 Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."




Acts 3:22–23 (NKJV)

Matthew 28:18-20 (NKJV)


Hebrews 1:1–2 (NKJV)


John 12:48 (NKJV)

⁴⁸ He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.




Matthew 24:35 (NKJV)

Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. (cf. Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33)



1 Peter 1:22–25 (NKJV)

²² Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, ²³ having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, ²⁴ because "All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away,"



1 Peter 1:22-25 (NKJV)

²⁵ But the word of the Lord endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.



Galatians 1:6–8 (NKJV)

⁶ I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, 7 which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.



Jude 3 (NKJV)

³ Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS

 CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY

 AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
 - Men may drift away from the truth, but the truth is still the truth (Ps. 119:89; Jude 3)
 - Men may attempt to change the gospel of Christ, but the truth cannot be changed (Gal. 1:6-9; Rom. 3:4; 2 Co. 11:4; 2 Pe. 3:15-18)
 - THE TRUTH HAS NOT CHANGED WITH TIME!



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS

 CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY

 AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
 - Sin is still sin and will prevent all who practice it from entering heaven (John 8:34; 1 Cor. 6:9,10; Gal. 5:19,20; Rom.
 - 6:1-23; Acts 17:30; etc.)
 - Attempts to redefine sin, normalize sin, laugh at sin, or legalize sin, will NEVER prevent those guilty of experiencing its eternal consequences (Rom 6:23; Ro. 1:18-32; 2 The. 1:7-9)

- THE TEACHING OF JESUS

 CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY

 AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
 - Available to ALL (Acts 2:21,38; Rom. 10:13-17; Col. 1:23)
 - Demands reverence for God (Prov. 1:7; Eccl. 12:13; Heb. 12:28; Ro. 11:20; 1 Pe. 1:17)
 - Demands we give glory to God (Lu. 17:18; Mal. 2:2)
 - Demands worship in Spirit & truth (John 4:23,24; Ac. 14:15; 17:23–25; 1 Pe. 2:9)



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS

 CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY

 AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
 - The same "good news" proclaimed in the first century can still save us from sin and its eternal consequences (Mat. 28:20; Mk 16:15,16; Ro. 1:16,17)
 - By what Jesus accomplished through His death, burial and resurrection, all who call upon the name of the Lord by faith will be saved (Acts 2:21,38-47; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21; etc.)





Hebrews 10:32-39 (NKJV)

³² But recall the former days in which, after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings: 33 partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated; ³⁴ for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven. ³⁵ Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. ³⁶ For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: ³⁷ "For yet a little while, And He who is coming will come and will not tarry. ³⁸ Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him." 39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.
