## **Revelation 14:6–7 (NKJV)**

<sup>6</sup> Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—<sup>7</sup> saying with a loud voice, “Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.”

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL

## **Romans 1:16–17 (NKJV)**

<sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “*The just shall live by faith.*”



# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



- THE GOSPEL (GOOD NEWS) OF CHRIST includes:
  - ▶ **FACTS** which MUST BE BELIEVED (Mark 1:15; John 8:24; 1 Cor. 15:1-4; Rom. 10:4-17)
  - ▶ **TEACHING** which MUST BE FOLLOWED (Mat. 28:19,20; Luke 6:46; 9:23-26; Rom. 1:5; 10:16; 16:25,26; 2 Thes. 1:7-9; 1 Pet. 4:27; 2 John 9)
  - ▶ **PROMISES** to be received (Col. 1:23; Ro. 5:5; Ga. 5:5; Ep. 1:18; 1 Th. 5:8; 2 Th. 2:16; Tit. 3:7; He. 6:19; 1 Pe. 1:3; 1 Jno. 3:1-3)

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## Deuteronomy 18:18–19 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. <sup>19</sup> And it shall be *that* whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require *it* of him.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## John 1:45 (NKJV)

<sup>45</sup> Philip found Nathanael and said to him, “We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.”

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## John 6:14 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## Acts 3:22–23 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup> For Moses truly said to the fathers, *‘The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you.* <sup>23</sup> *And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.’*

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## Matthew 28:18–20 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age.” Amen.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## Hebrews 1:1–2 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, <sup>2</sup> has in these last days spoken to us by *His* Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## John 12:48 (NKJV)

48 He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## Matthew 24:35 (NKJV)

35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.  
(cf. Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33)

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## 1 Peter 1:22–25 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup> Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, <sup>23</sup> having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, <sup>24</sup> because “*All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away,*

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



## 1 Peter 1:22–25 (NKJV)

25 But the word of the Lord endures forever.” Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL

## **Galatians 1:6–8 (NKJV)**

<sup>6</sup> I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, <sup>7</sup> which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. <sup>8</sup> But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL

## **Jude 3 (NKJV)**

<sup>3</sup> Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
- ▶ Men may drift away from the truth, but the truth is still the truth (Ps. 119:89; Jude 3)
- ▶ Men may attempt to change the gospel of Christ, but the truth cannot be changed (Gal. 1:6-9; Rom. 3:4; 2 Co. 11:4; 2 Pe. 3:15-18)
- ▶ THE TRUTH HAS NOT CHANGED WITH TIME!

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
- ▶ Sin is still sin and will prevent all who practice it from entering heaven (John 8:34; 1 Cor. 6:9,10; Gal. 5:19,20; Rom. 6:1-23; Acts 17:30; etc.)
- ▶ Attempts to redefine sin, normalize sin, laugh at sin, or legalize sin, will NEVER prevent those guilty of experiencing its eternal consequences (Rom 6:23; Ro. 1:18-32; 2 The. 1:7-9)

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL

## ■ THE TEACHING OF JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!

- ▶ Available to ALL (Acts 2:21,38; Rom. 10:13-17; Col. 1:23)
- ▶ Demands reverence for God (Prov. 1:7; Eccl. 12:13; Heb. 12:28; Ro. 11:20; 1 Pe. 1:17)
- ▶ Demands we give glory to God (Lu. 17:18; Mal. 2:2)
- ▶ Demands worship in Spirit & truth (John 4:23,24; Ac. 14:15; 17:23–25; 1 Pe. 2:9)

# THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL



- THE TEACHING OF JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME TODAY AS IT WAS WHEN FIRST GIVEN!
- ▶ The same “good news” proclaimed in the first century can still save us from sin and its eternal consequences (Mat. 28:20; Mk 16:15,16; Ro. 1:16,17)
- ▶ By what Jesus accomplished through His death, burial and resurrection, all who call upon the name of the Lord by faith will be saved (Acts 2:21,38-47; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21; etc.)

## Hebrews 10:32–39 (NKJV)

<sup>32</sup> But recall the former days in which, after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings: <sup>33</sup> partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated; <sup>34</sup> for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven. <sup>35</sup> Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. <sup>36</sup> For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: <sup>37</sup> *“For yet a little while, And He who is coming will come and will not tarry. <sup>38</sup> Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”* <sup>39</sup> But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.
