A Word of Exhortation to the Hebrews

Not a typical epistle (no intro; has ending)

Paul probably author (Acts 13:15,16-41)

Hebrews are Jews living in Judea and Galilee (a few exceptions like Paul that speak Hebrew)

Jews' slander of Paul would be a reason to be anonymous

Christians believed in its inspiration, most thought it was from Paul

Only problem is 2:3-4 vs. Galatians 1-2

Time is before destruction of Jerusalem 8:13

A Word of Exhortation to the Hebrews

"Let us" statements prominent

Hortatory Subjunctive

Not a superior ordering compliance by a subordinate

A partner in a team encouraging everyone to work together for the good of all

Sounds like Barnabas, but Paul said this often (5x in Rom. 13:12-14:19; 4x in 12 verses Gal.5:25-6:10; 3x each in Phil. 3:15-16 & 1 Th 5:6-8; Jesus used it often, esp. in Mark

Let Us Statements in Hebrews

- 4:1 since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it
- 4:11,14,16 *
- 6:1 leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection
- 10:22,23,24 *
- 12:1 (2x) let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us
- 12:28 let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear

13:13,15 11 For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. 12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. 13 Therefore let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. 14 For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come. 15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. 16 But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

A Word of Exhortation to the Hebrews

- Key verses in the middle of the book. This is usually an indication of a "sandwich"
- First read the term "sandwich" in an article about the "Genesis Death Sandwich." 2013
- It was a faulty way of finding true chiastic X structure
- Examples: Tree of Life Gen. 2, Tree of Death 1 Peter 2:24, Tree of Life Rev. 22

Shadow then object then glorious eternal light First the natural, then the spiritual 1 Cor. 15:46 Colossians 2:16-17 so let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, 17 which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ. Old law was physical, natural shadow of true spiritual reality in Christ
