12 Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him; and the people feared the presence of the LORD. 13 Then Haggai, the LORD's messenger, spoke the LORD's message to the people by saying, "I am with you, says the LORD." 14 This is how the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and worked on the house of the LORD of armies, their God. 6/24/520B.C.

We are to glorify God v.8; Ephesians 4:11-16

Consider our ways daily v.3,7; Matthew 6:11-10 2 Corinthians 13:5; 3:18; Hebrews 12:3; Jm 4:17

Be doers of the word, not just hearers Jm 1:22

² "Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, saying: 3 'Who is left among you who saw this temple in its former glory? And how do you see it now? In comparison with it, is this not in your eyes as nothing? 4 Yet now be strong, Zerubbabel,' says the LORD; 'and be strong, Joshua, son of Jehozadak, the high priest; and be strong, all you people of the land,' says the LORD, 'and work; for I am with you,' says the LORD of armies. 5 'According to the word that I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt, so My Spirit remains among you; do not fear!""

'And in this place I will give peace,' says the LORD of armies."
