- There are NO shortcuts to salvation or spiritual growth ... Nor can we substitute our convenient ways for God's commands.




A WALLEY OF COUNCILOIS ON COUNTINE (S)


AUTITED OF COUNCILOUS COUNTINES



A MATTER OF CONVICTION OR CONVENIENCE? Ther Questions & Applications

- Are you serving God only when it's easy and fits neatly into your schedule?
- Do you "deny yourself" and "sacrifice" your plans and wants for God's purposes, or do you prioritize your own comfort?
- Are you willing to serve even when you feel unappreciated or unnoticed?

THE WAY OF SALVATION IS NOT A WAY OF CONVENIENCE

- Truth is contrary to human wisdom (Isaiah 55:8,9; 1 Cor. 1:18,19; Acts 2:38; 22:16)
- The way of salvation is straight, narrow & difficult (Mat. 7:13,14)
- Requires complete submission & surrender (Luke 14:26,27,33)

THE WAY OF SALVATION IS NOT A WAY OF CONVENIENCE

- Our faith and actions must be based on what is true, right, good and holy, rather than what is easy or feels good! (Mat 16:24; Rom 12:1,2)
- © Commitment to the Lord, to His church, and to this local work requires CONVICTION!




Acts 24:24-25 (NKJV)
