

Matthew 22:15-21

15 Then the Pharisees went and plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk. 16 And they sent to Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that You are true, and teach the way of God in truth; nor do You care about anyone, for You do not regard the person of men. 17 Tell us, therefore, what do You think? Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?"

13 Therefore submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme, 14 or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and praise of those who do good. ¹⁵ For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men— 16 as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God. 17 Honor all. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.

Romans 13:1-7

1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. ² Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same.

Romans 13:1-7

4 For he is God's minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil 5 Therefore you must be subject, not only because of wrath but also for conscience' sake.

⁶ For because of this you also pay taxes, for they are God's ministers attending continually to this very thing. ⁷ Render therefore to all their due: taxes to whom taxes, customs to whom customs, fear to whom fear, honor to whom honor.

Giving by God

Remnant returned, furnished their paneled houses, finally finished the temple; the Jews were comfortable

Temple service became regular routine

Malachi is the last book of the Old Testament (late 5th Century B.C.)

Perfect segue to the first books of the New Testament

The message: DON'T ROB GOD!

1:2-5 by questioning His love and His righteousness 2:17; Rom. 5:8; 3:26

Romans 3:23-26

²⁴ being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus ²⁵ whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness...

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

- 1:2-5 by questioning His love and His righteousness 2:17; Rom. 5:8; 3:26
- 1:6-14 by their actions and attitudes toward "worshipping" God Matt. 15:8-9
 compared to honor for father v.6 and governor v.8
- 2:1-9 "priests" example led people AWAY FROM God instead of TO God James 3:1
- 2:10-16 by misusing His gifts to them 1 Peter 3:7

3:1-7 future messenger to command repentance v.7 before the Lord Jesus comes also 4:5-6; Mark 1:2-3; Matt. 11:10,14

Matthew 7:11-15

7 As they departed, Jesus began to say to the multitudes concerning John: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind? 8 But what did you go out to see? A man clothed in soft garments? Indeed, those who wear soft clothing are in kings' houses. 9 But what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I say to you, and more than a prophet. 10 For this is he of whom it is written: 'Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, Who will prepare Your way before You."

Matthew 7:11-15

11 "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. 12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. 13 For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. 14 And if you are willing to receive it, he is Elijah who is to come."

- 3:8-12 by not giving according to God's word
- 3:13-15 by criticizing God
- 3:16-18 God will reward those who didn't agree with God's critics
- 4:1-6 John preceeds coming judgment A.D.70

Giving to God

What do we have that belongs to God? Whatever has His image Genesis 1:26-27 Whatever has His name Ephesians 3:14-15 Give nothing less than your whole being! Ecclesiastes 12:13; Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Matthew 22:37-39; Romans 12:1

Satan will try to separate us from God by getting us to give less than He is worthy (less love, less trust, less time, less effort)
