By example **Mark 5:19** (**how God wanted to be known** **Exodus 33:19**) **Mark 8:2; Matt. 15:32**

By parables **Matt. 18:27; Luke 10:25-37; 15:20**

The Compassion of Christ in Us

Transform into the image of Christ 2 Cor.

3:17-18 (glorification)

Renew the inner man daily 2 Cor. 4:16

2 Cor. 6:12 Corinth's emotional constipation

Example of Titus for Corinthians 2 Cor. 7:15

Paul's example Philippians 1:8; 2:1

Colossians 3:12 *put on Christ...tender mercies*

Philemon 7,12,20 affectionate brotherly love

1 John 3:17 love → compassion 2 Cor. 5:14-17

2 Corinthians 5:14-17

14 For **the love of Christ compels us**, because we judge thus: that since **One died for all, then all died**; **15** and **He died for all**, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

16 Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know *Him thus* no longer. **17** Therefore, if **anyone is in Christ**, *he is a new creation*; old things have passed away; behold, **all things have become new**.

Luke 15:11-32 our repentance → God's joy

Luke 18:1-8 *God suffers long with us*

John 11:1-45 *See how much He loved him*

Luke 10:25-37 compassion → action

Colossians 3:12-17 compassion for one
another

1 John 3:11-19 no compassion = no love
