
1 "Man who is born of woman Is of few days and full of trouble.

Question may also be asked in sincerity: "How could God let this happen to me and to mine, why would God not stop this pain and help me?"






2 Corinthians 12:7–10 (NKJV)











Those In Darkness Hate Those In The Light



Sin is the Problem - Not God




