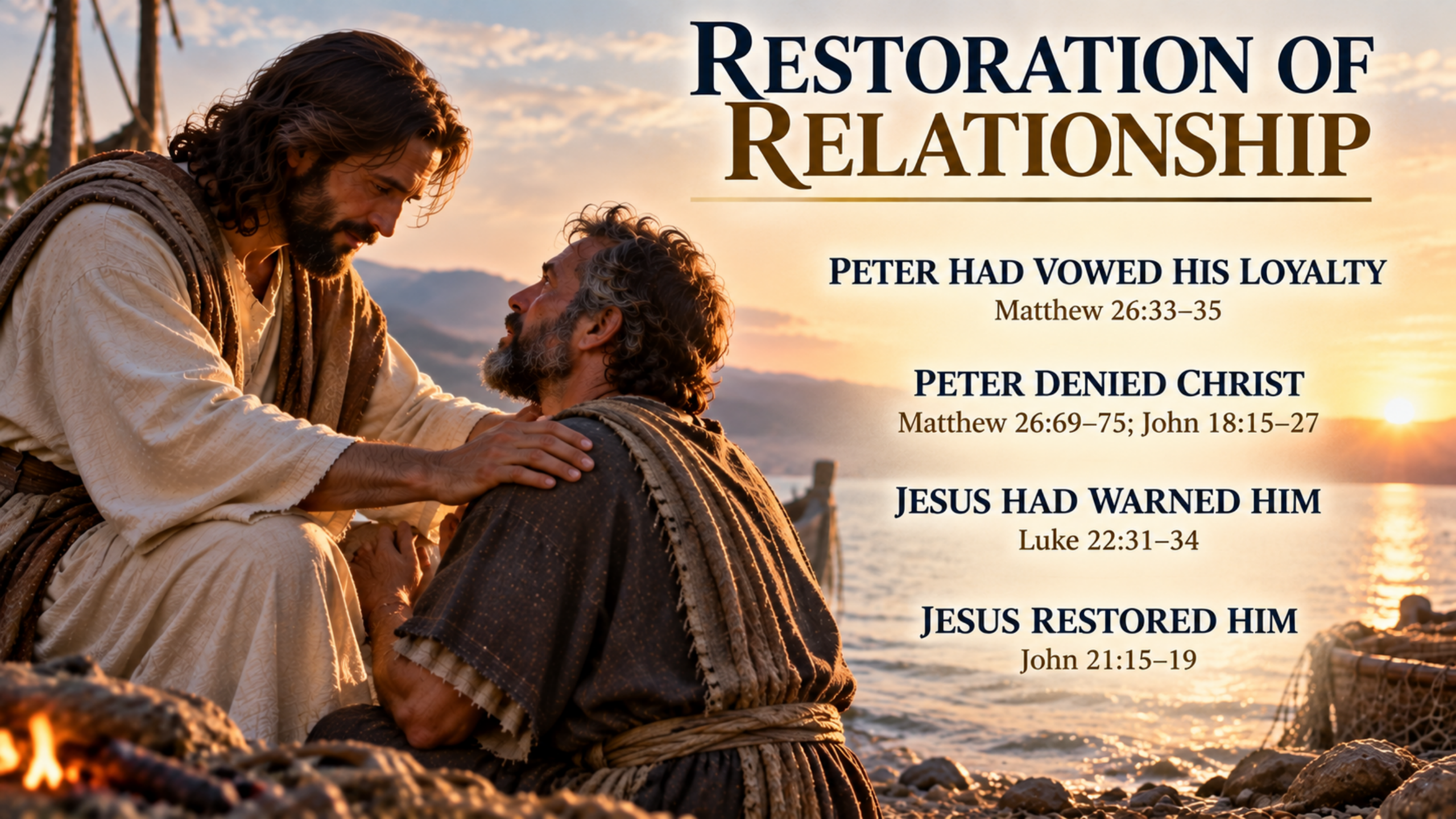

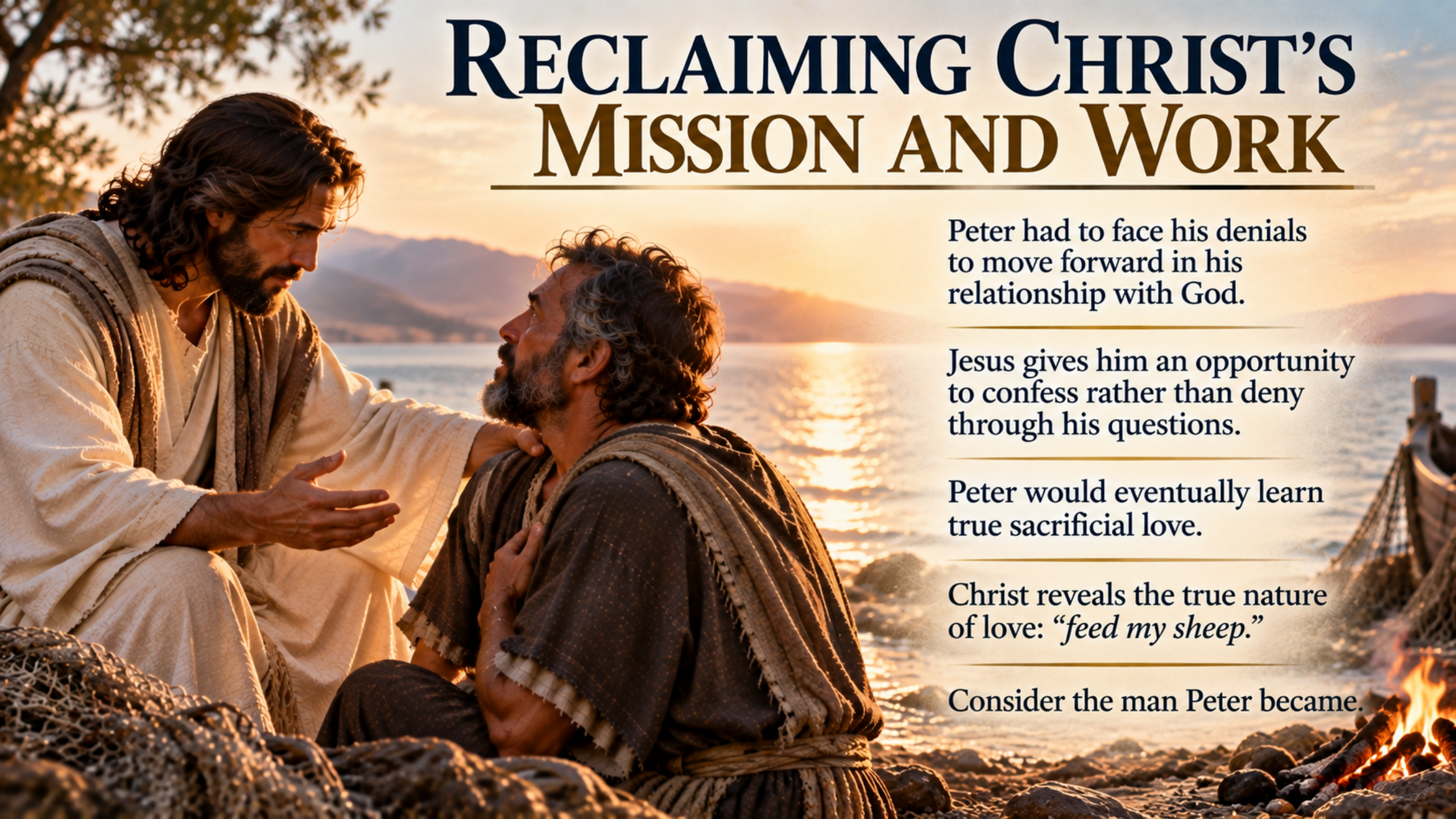

RECLAIMING CHRIST'S MISSION AND WORK

Peter had to face his denials to move forward in his relationship with God.

Jesus gives him an opportunity to confess rather than deny through his questions.

Peter would eventually learn true sacrificial love.

Christ reveals the true nature of love: *"feed my sheep."*

Consider the man Peter became.

Keep Jesus at the Center of This Restoration:

Jesus comes looking for Peter.

Jesus questions Peter.

Jesus forgives Peter.

Jesus calls Peter again.

Jesus tells Peter to follow Him.

Ultimate Calling: “They left everything and followed Him”
