because of evil motives v.3

Some teaching in the Old Testament is
about universal principles v.3-5; Gen.
1:26-27; 2:24

Genesis 1:26-27

God (plural) **said** (singular), “**Let us** (plural) **make** (singular) **man** (singular) in **our** (plural) **own image** (singular), according to **our** (plural) **likeness** (singular); let **them** (plural) **have dominion** (plural) over the fish (singular) of the sea (singular), over the fowl (singular) of the air (plural), over the large beast (singular) over the land (singular), and over every (singular) crawling (singular) creature (singular) that crawls (singular) on the land (singular). So **God** (plural) **created** (singular) **man** (singular) in **His** (singular) **own image** (singular), in the **image** (singular) **of God** (plural) **He created** (singular) **him** (singular); **male** (singular) and **female** (singular) **He created** (singular) **them** (plural).

Genesis 2:24

“Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and shall cleave to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.”

Matthew 19:5

“For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.”

God allowed some iniquity to continue even
if it was contrary to His will v.8; Acts 17:30

Divorce and marriage to another person is
adultery (with one exception) v.9; 5:27-32

Matthew 5:31-32

“Furthermore it has been said, ‘Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.’ But I say to you that whoever divorces his wife for any reason except sexual immorality causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery.”

Matthew 5:27-30

“You have heard that it was said to those of old, ‘You shall not commit adultery.’ But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast *it* from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and cast it from you; cast *it* from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

Mark 10:13-16

Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought *them*. But when Jesus saw it, He was saw *it*, He was greatly displeased and said to them, “Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. ¹⁵ Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it.” ¹⁶ And He took them up in His arms, laid *His* hands on them, and blessed them.
