

THEME

John 20:30-31 (NKJV) <sup>30</sup> And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; <sup>31</sup> but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

<sup>27</sup> And at this *point* His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?" <sup>28</sup> The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, <sup>29</sup> "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" 30 Then they went out of the city and came to Him.



<sup>31</sup> In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." <sup>32</sup> But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know." 33 Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" 34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.



<sup>35</sup> Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! <sup>36</sup> And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. 37 For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.'




<sup>38</sup> I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors." <sup>39</sup> And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did." 40 So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days.

<sup>41</sup> And many more believed because of His own word. <sup>42</sup> Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world."

- The value of every soul regardless of race, social status or background In 3:16; Ac 10:34,35; Ja 2:1-13


- The woman leaves her water pot to run and tell others about Jesus (28; cf. Acts 4:20; 8:4; 10:24,33; 1 Thes 1:8)
- How wonderful it would be if every Christian had this kind of enthusiasm for the Gospel! (Eph 2:10; Titus 2:11-14)

#### THE EXCITEMENT LIVING WATER CAUSES

- ♦ Enthusiasm is contagious -
- If we are disinterested in the gospel & the church, we will not be motivated to spread the gospel.
- Even if we do out of a sense of duty & obligation without enthusiasm, our efforts will be ineffective.



Jesus was tired & thirsty.





- John 4:33-34 (NKJV) <sup>33</sup> Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.
- Desus was tired & thirsty.

  But now food & drink were not important to Him. His mood had changed.
- His great passion and desire was to do God's will (cf. 5:30; 8:29; Deut. 8:3).
- His priority is spiritual the Father's work must be done (cf. John 17:4).




- Four months more and then the harvest was probably a local proverb.
- The opportunity for making believers was now the Samaritans were coming.
- If the disciples would look around, they would see people with spiritual hunger. (v. 30)



- How do we view those around us in the world?
- Do we suppose that those in denominationalism are not worth talking to because we think they can't be changed?
- What about those who know nothing or show little interest in spiritual things?

John 4:36-38 (NKJV) <sup>36</sup> And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. <sup>37</sup> For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.'

- Sowers & reapers benefit from their work together this is definitely true in spiritual matters - 1 Cor 1:1217; 3:5-15;
- As reapers, the disciples had the great and rewarding privilege of leading people to faith in Christ.




- Others had already sown, (perhaps a reference to the the O.T. prophets, but more probable a reference to John the Baptist)
  - Jesus' disciples were involved in ministry to others, in the issue of death and life (2 Cor. 2:15-16).


