

⁸ And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment

elenchou (ejlevgcw, (1651) signifies (a) to convict, confute, refute, usually with the suggestion of putting the convicted person to shame; see Matt. 18:15, where more than telling the offender his fault is in view; it is used of convicting of sin, John 8:46; 16:8; gainsayers in regard to the faith, Tit. 1:9; transgressors of the Law, Jas. 2:9; some texts have the verb in John 8:9; -



"Convict the world of:

- * "SIN because they do not believe in Me" Acts 2:22,23
- * "RIGHTEOUSNESS, because I go to My Father"- Acts 2:32,33
- * "JUDGMENT, because the ruler of this world is judged" (cf. 14:30) Acts 2:34-37



- The Word of God
 Sufficient to convict! Heb 4:12; Lk 8:11; Is 55:11
- Through Reason Not Emotion! Acts 17:2; 24:25
- Compliance does Not Always Follow Conviction - Acts 24:25, [Felix] -26:25-29, [Agrippa]

convert, conversion

epistrephoμ (**ejpistrevfw**, (1994)), to turn about, turn towards (**epi,** towards and No. 1), is used transitively, and so rendered "convert" (of causing a person to turn) in Jas. 5:19, 20. . . . "turn again," Matt. 13:15; Mark 4:12; Luke 22:32; Acts 3:19; 28:27.

epistropheµ (ejpistrofhv, Noun (1995), akin to A, No. 2, a turning about, or round, conversion, is found in Acts 15:3. The word implies a turning from and a turning to; corresponding to these are repentance and faith; cp. "turned to God from idols" (1 Thess. 1:9). Divine grace is the efficient cause, human agency the responding effect.

The Sovereignty of God the Holy Spirit in Salvation - Arthur W. Pink That the work of the Holy Spirit precedes our believing is unequivocally established by 2 Thess. 2:13—"God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth." Note that sanctification of the Spirit comes before and makes possible—"belief of the truth." What then is the "sanctification of the Spirit"? We answer, the new birth.


