
1 Samuel 24:8-15




- Actions speak louder than words 1 Pet 2:17-22; Eph 6:5-7




- ◆ Saul was awakened to his guilt "you are more righteous than I"— 24:17; 26:21





<sup>1</sup> To the Chief Musician. Set to 'Do Not Destroy.' A Michtam of David when he fled from Saul into the cave. Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, Until these calamities have passed by. <sup>2</sup> I will cry out to God Most High, To God who performs all things for me.

<sup>3</sup> He shall send from heaven and save me; He reproaches the one who would swallow me up. Selah God shall send forth His mercy and His truth. <sup>4</sup> My soul is among lions; I lie among the sons of men Who are set on fire, Whose teeth are spears and arrows, And their tongue a sharp sword. <sup>5</sup> Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; Let Your glory be above all the earth.

<sup>6</sup> They have prepared a net for my steps; My soul is bowed down; They have dug a pit before me; Into the midst of it they themselves have fallen.
