1 John 2:15–17 (NKJV)

¹⁵ Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. 17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.



Galatians 5:19–21 (NKJV) 19 Now the works of the flesh . . . adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; . . .




The Folly of Worldliness WHATIS WORLDLINESS?

Given to following passions

1 Corinthians 6:9–11 (NKJV)

9 . . . fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, 10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.




WHATIS WORLDLINESS?

Given to following passions

James 3:14–16 (NKJV)

¹⁴ But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. ¹⁵ This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. ¹⁶ For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.



WHAT IS WORLDLINESS?

The sphere of iniquity

Ephesians 2:1–3 (NKJV)

... who were dead in trespasses and sins, ² in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, ³ among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.




WHAT IS WORLDLINESS?

2 John 9 (NKJV)

⁹ Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.




WHATIS WORLDLINESS?

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Of the World - Not Separate

James 4:4 (NKJV)

⁴ Adulterers and adulteresses!

Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.




WHAT IS WORLDLINESS?

¹ If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ² Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.




WHATIS WORLDLINESS?

19 "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; 20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. 21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.




WHATIS WORLDLINESS?




WHATS WORLDLINESS?

Matthew 6:19–24 (NKJV)


²⁴ "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

A Person Who Drinks, uses drugs, Curses, goes clubbing, & wears immodest clothing, etc. Is Worldly...



WHAT IS WORLDLINESS?

A Person Can Be Worldly & be a "GOOD PERSON"...

- Moral, benevolent,
 dependable, religious BUT if
 Not In Christ WORLDLY NOT Spiritual! Rom 8:I-I2,
 Mat 7:2I-23; I5:7-9
- If any man is IN CHRIST he is a new creature 2 Cor 5:17-19; Eph I:3; Gal 3:26,27

Colossians 2:8 (NKJV)

8 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.

THE WICKEDNESS OF WORLDLINESS



1 Corinthians 3:18–20 (NKJV)

18 Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. 19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their own craftiness";

20 and again, "The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."

THE WICKEDNESS OF WORLDLINESS



- Attitude towards the
 - World James 4:4
 - Worldly 2 Cor 6:14-7:1
 - Word of God 2 Thes 2:10-12
 - Faithful Christian who uncompromisingly stands for the truth Luke 6:22

THE WICKEDNESS OF WORLDLINESS

Worldly Living:

- Destroys my influence (Mat. 5:13,14; Rom. 2:24; Phili 2:15)
- Makes my worship vain (Prov. I:28,29; Mic. 3:4; Mat 15:7-9; Jn 9:31)
- Hinders my race and growth (Heb. I2:I-ff)
- Disfellowship (I Cor. 5:I-I3; 2 Thess. 3:6-I5)

THE WICKEDNESS OF WORLDLINESS

Worldly Living:

- Desensitizes to sin (Eccl. 5:1; Rom 8:5; I Cor. 2:14)
- Separates from God (Isa. 59:I-2; Rom. 8:7,8; James 4:4)
- Heart becomes hardened (Mat. 13:15; Heb. 3:8,13)
- Suffer in this life (Prov. 13:15: Jer. 2:19; Rom. 6:21)
- Eternal damnation (Rom. 6:23; Gal. 5:19-21; Rev. 21:8)

THE WICKEDNESS OF WORLDLINESS

"If we love the world or the things in the world" ... 1 John 2:15-17

We alienate ourselves from God.

"If any man love the world, the love of the father is not in him." -

We are wrong. ``For all that is in the world is not of the Father, but is of the world.' - cf - Ep 2:2

It is temporary. "The world passeth away, and the lust thereof." - cf Heb II:25

cf. James 4:4

1 John 2:15–17

- ". . . but he who does the will of God abides forever."
- cf Mat 7:21; Jn 7:17; H∈b 10:36.
- Obey the gospel Rom 6:3-6, 16-18; 2 Thes 1:7-9; Col 1:13; 2:12
- Grow in knowledge of Christ 2
 Pet I:5-IO; 3:I6-I8
- Put on Christ Col 3:12-17



THE WIGTORY OWER WORLDLINESS

There is a better way ...

1 John 2:15–17

- Not to continue to sin (Ps. II9:II; Rom. 6; I Jn 3:I-IO)
- Separate from world (2 Cor. 6:14-17)
- Abstain from every form of evil - (I Thes. 5:21,22)
- Holy / Pure / Godly (I Pet. I:15-16; 4:1-3; I John 3:3; I Tim. 2:9; 4:8)




There is a better way ...

² By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments. ³ For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

⁴ For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. ⁵ Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

James 1:27 (NKJV) ²⁷ Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.

¹ If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ² Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.




There is a better way ...
