(Proverbs 4:23) The Bible Heart - (kardia) – Thayer, 2b) "the centre and seat of spiritual life; the soul or mind, as it is the fountain and seat of the thoughts, passions, desires, appetites, affections, purposes, endeavours..."

Heart in Hebrew can refer to one's emotions (*Prov. 12:25; 13:12; 14:10, 13*) but most often to his intellect (*such as understanding, 10:8; discernment, 15:14; reflection, 15:28*), or will (5:12).





"Keep it"—"guard it," or "watch over it." Implies value & the importance of the heart. Implies the need for the heart to be protected and guarded - it is in danger or jeopardy -

"With all vigilance" -

Literally, the Hebrew text says, "more than all vigilance," or "more than all guarding," "more than all protecting," keep your heart. Your most valuable, important possession & your most pressing & important obligation - (Prov 23:7)





(Proverbs 4:23) **Necessary Qualities** -Ch 3:1-12 **Hunger** to understand God's word - (vv. 1-4) **Trust** in God and not own understanding (vv. 5-6), **Fear** God and not be wise in his own eyes (vv. 7-8), Honor God and not fail to give to Him (vv. 9-10) **Appreciate** God and not misunderstand His discipline (VV. 11-12).

How To Keep / Protect Our Heart **Necessary Actions**

Feed upon, retain, keep, love, exalt, hold on to, give attention to, incline your heart to God's word - (4:1-22; Ps 119:9-16; 1 Pet 2:2; Rom 10:16)

Govern your intake, actions & associates - eyes, ears, hands & feet - (Mt 5:22; Prov 1:10-15; 1 Cor 15:33; etc.)

Purify your thoughts, desires **& deeds** - (Ps 119:9; Ez. 18:31; Jas 4:7-10; Mat 23:25,26; 1 Jn 3:3).
