

What Can We
Learn From The
Prayers of Paul?

- In most of Paul's letters, he includes a prayer for his readers.
- Paul's prayers are touching, profound, eloquent, & loving; . . . they are Instructional, inspirational, & powerful.

- Paul's heart was fixed on the essential things, things true, important & indispensable.
- Paul's prayers, then, become a mirror in which we can examine ourselves. - Are we concerned about the same things as Paul?

#### Ephesians 1:15-21 (NKJV)

Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, <sup>16</sup> do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: <sup>17</sup> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,



#### Ephesians 1:15-21 (NKJV)

18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power

<sup>20</sup> which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

- Colossians 1:11 (NKJV) 11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy;
- Thes. 3:13 "... so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God...."
- 2 Thes. 2:16 "... in every good work and word."

#### Ephesians 3:14-19 (NKJV)

to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man

- > Philippians 4:13 (NKJV) 13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 (NKJV) 9 "And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

For Strength - For Ourselves & Others

Without God's strength we are helpless - but with the strength God provides through faith - we can overcome & fulfill His will for us, That we may receive all that God desires to give us! Heb 5:8.9; 1 Cor 10:13; Eph 6:10-18

- Thessalonians 3:5 (NKJV) "Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ."
- Romans 15:5-6 (NKJV) 5 Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be **like-minded toward one another**, according to Christ Jesus, 6 that you may with **one mind and one mouth glorify the God** and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### Colossians 4:3 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup> meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in chains,

- Thessalonians 3:1 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup> Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified, just as it is with you,
- Ephesians 6:19 (NKJV) 19 and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,
- Philemon 6 (NKJV) 6 that the sharing of your faith may become effective . . .

For The Salvation of Those Who Are Lost

#### Romans IO:I (NKJV)

- "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved." (cf. 9:1-3)
- Corinthians 9:20–23 (NKJV) <sup>20</sup> and to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews; to those who are under the law, as under the law, that I might win those who are under the law; <sup>21</sup> to those who are without law, as without law . . . I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some. <sup>23</sup> Now this I do for the gospel's sake, that I may be partaker of it with you.

- Paul's heart was fixed on the essential things, things true, important and indispensable.
- Are we primarily concerned with the same issues that concerned Paul?
  - \* Our knowledge, wisdom, understanding, holiness, obedience, endurance, joy, opportunities, salvation of those who are lost?

- If you are a Christian & you realize you need to make changes in your life your priorities are not where they should be do whatever you need to do today!
- If You are not a Christian, our prayer is that today you will obey the gospel Acts 22:16
